## SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

To all applicants,

The Lakeland Officials Association was organized in 1959 and presently has a membership of over one hundred who work in several youth, high school, college and adult sports. The purpose of our Association is to obtain uniform interpretation of sports' rules, to improve officiating techniques, and to foster high standards of officiating.

In 1998 the L.O.A. increased its community involvement footprint by establishing a scholarship fund for graduating high schools' seniors in the Waukesha County area. Each year we try to assist graduating Seniors in their post-secondary educational expenses. The awards are typically in the amount of \$500 to \$1500 each. To date we have granted 191 scholarships, over \$203,000. These awards are not based on any one criterion, and all timely received scholarship applications are reviewed by a committee of at least eight members.
