Letter of Intent to Sell for All Animals

You and your animal(s) must meet these requirements:

1. The animal(s) must be under the control, care and feeding of the 4-H/FFA member who will show. **You must include care and management in your record book.** Members must be present at the weigh-ins to handle the animal.
2. The animals are on an appropriate feeding program, following the guidelines of the 4-H Quality Assurance Program. **You must include a health record for your animal in your record book. Please read market regulations for Wahkiakum 4-H on the website or obtain a copy from the 4-H office.**
3. You will be required to solicit at least two buyers per species. Give the name/business, mailing address, and phone number to the 4-H Office. **Check the 4-H calendar for due dates.**
4. Minimum live weight to sell on Sale day is/or breed standard:
 - Beef -- 900#
 - Swine -- 190#
 - Sheep -- 90#
 - Goat -- 45#
 - Poultry Fryers -- 5#
 - Rabbit Fryers -- 5#
 - Ducks, Turkeys, Geese – contact Extension office, weight determined by breed
5. Sale of production animals under 1 year of age is allowed.
6. While the participant is at the Fair, they will be required to participate in the following activities:
 - All barn duties required including herdsmanhip of animals.
 - Check in with the Sale Committee on the day of sale for sale schedule/order
 - Show and sell in neat, clean and appropriate clothing per show requirements
 - Type a short biography of yourself, including why you are participating in market sale, to be read by the Sale Auctioneer. **Due to the office with a poster for the fair.**
 - Create an educational poster for each division on breed and market and/or production weight. **Check the 4-H calendar for due dates.**
 - Write a thank-you note to your buyer and turn into the Extension office in a stamped, addressed envelope as soon as possible after the sale. **This must be received before your sale check is released. Check the 4-H calendar for due dates.**
 - Attend a Quality Assurance workshop (or equivalent training approved by the Market Sale Committee), once every three years after the first initial training, prior to the show date.
