TIMES NEW ROMAN, 12PT, BOLD, CENTER, CAPITAL**

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3-5 keywords separated by a semicolon (;) (Times New Roman, 10pt, single spacing)

Abstract: The abstract should be clear, concise, and descriptive. Use Times New Roman, 11 pt, single spacing. Word limitations are 100-200 words. This abstract should provide a brief background of the problem, clear objective of the paper, research method, a summary of results/findings, and a short conclusion. The abstract should not contain equations and citations.

INTRODUCTION

The manuscript must be written in English and prepared using the official MS Word article template. The text should be formatted in Times New Roman, 12-point font, with single line spacing. The document must be set on A4 paper size, with margins of 3 cm for the top and left sides, and 2.5 cm for the bottom and right sides. The total length of the manuscript should not exceed 12 pages, including all components such as text, tables, figures, and references.

The structure of the manuscript should consist of the following sections: Abstract, Introduction, Literature Review, Methodology, Results, Conclusions, and References. In the Introduction section, authors are expected to present sufficient background information along with a concise review of relevant literature to highlight existing approaches or solutions. This section should also clearly emphasize the scientific contribution or novelty of the study. Furthermore, the research objectives should be explicitly stated at the end of the Introduction.

MATERIAL AND METHOD

This section contains data sources, research variables, sampling techniques, data collection methods and data analysis methods. The data analysis method used must be described in detail.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The results section should be presented in a clear and concise manner, focusing on summarizing the key scientific findings rather than displaying raw data in excessive detail. Authors are encouraged to emphasize how their findings differ from or contribute beyond previously published studies.

The discussion section should interpret and explain the significance of the findings instead of simply repeating the results. In many cases, combining the Results and Discussion sections can be appropriate. Authors should also avoid overusing citations or providing lengthy reviews of existing literature in this section.

The discussion represents a crucial part of the manuscript, as it provides an opportunity to demonstrate the value and relevance of the research findings. It should be closely aligned with the results while avoiding redundancy. Typically, the discussion begins with a brief overview of the main scientific contributions rather than a restatement of detailed experimental outcomes.

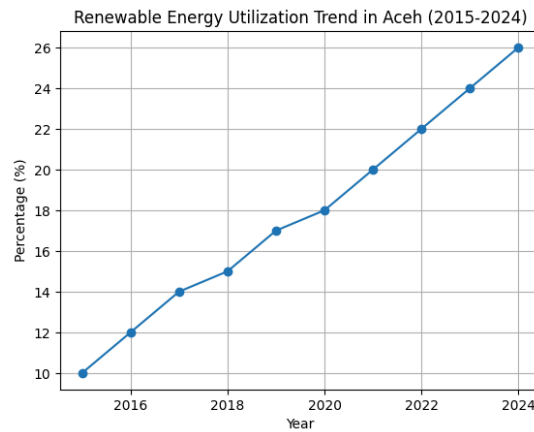


Figure 1. Renewable Energy Utilization in Aceh 2015-2024
