International Transcripts

Effective for any student applying for Fall 2023 admission and beyond, all post-secondary transcripts from non-U.S. institutions must be submitted directly to one of the following approved evaluation services for a detailed, course-by-course report. Applicants should allow 2–6 weeks for the evaluation to be completed.

- Educational Credential Evaluators (ECE)
 - Course-by-course report
 - Submit electronically using <u>ECE</u>
- World Education Services (WES)
 - Course-by-course evaluation
 - Submit electronically using <u>Access WES</u>

Please Note:

- The University of Michigan-Flint is unable to accept credential evaluations from agencies other than ECE or WES
- The University of Michigan-Flint is unable to review unofficial transcripts for an admission decision. All official transcripts must go to ECE or WES, and a course-by-course evaluation report sent to our office before a student can be considered for admission.
- The University of Michigan-Flint is unable to consider students for conditional admission pending receipt of the ECE or WES evaluation.
- The University of Michigan-Flint will not pay for students to obtain an ECE or WES evaluation.

** Transitional DPT Program - If educated outside the United States or Canada: Foreign Credentialing Commission on Physical Therapy (FCCPT) is recommended for those licensed in the U.S. or Canada; all others may use one of the above services.

** US Bridge to PT Credentialing - If educated outside the United States or Canada: FCCPT report that includes CWT6 section stating currently eligible to practice PT in the country in which the PT degree was awarded

These evaluation services are accredited through NACES, an association of independent, nongovernmental organizations providing credential evaluation services to individuals who have completed part or all of their education outside the United States.

Once the evaluation is completed, the transcript course-by-course evaluation report must be submitted to the University of Michigan-Flint. *This document must be submitted directly from the transcript evaluation company*. If you have not graduated at the time of evaluation, an official final transcript and certificate of graduation or diploma must be submitted to the Office of Graduate Programs at the University of Michigan-Flint.
