INSTRUCTION

REQUESTS FOR RECONSIDERATION OF AN INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIAL

The Wallingford Board of Education is legally responsible for all matters relating to the operation of the school district. A committee of professionally trained personnel employed by the school system (the "Curriculum Management Team") has the responsibility to recommend, develop, review, and approve all curricula for the district, subject to the approval of the Board of Education.

Requests for reconsideration of instructional materials shall be carefully investigated, but it must be recognized that the ultimate responsibility for selection of educational materials rests with school authorities.
