



Turner Middle School Summer Enrichment Courses

Middle School Classes are intended for those who have completed 6th-8th grade. Classes run - June 13 – July 15 with no classes being held July 1-5th. Some classes are limited in space. Students will be placed into classes on a first come first serve basis. You will be notified if your child does not get their first choice.

Class Offerings:

A World of Art

In middle school summer art class, students will be guided through projects using various media, while also being allowed the freedom to make their artwork their own. Students will use the creative process to produce multiple artworks using a variety of materials including watercolor, acrylic, mixed media, sculpture, and ceramics.

Athletic Conditioning (8:10-10:10 a.m. or 10:10a.m. -12:00 p.m.)

This course is recommended for anyone who is planning on becoming an athlete at Turner High School. The course is designed to give young athletes the opportunity to learn fitness concepts and conditioning techniques used for obtaining optimal physical fitness. Athletes will benefit from basic weight training and cardio-respiratory endurance activities. Athletes will work on strength training, aerobic training, agility, and overall fitness training.

Battle of the Books (8:10:00 a.m.)

This class provides an opportunity to read and discuss amazing books in a group setting while preparing for next year's competition. We will focus on the 20 books on the list for the 21-22 Battle of the Books program. (Participation in the Battle of the Books program next year is not required.) This class is for those who want to compete, those who enjoy learning about great books, and those who need more practice reading!

Remedial Courses (8:10-10:10 a.m. or 10:10a.m. -12:00 p.m.)

For students who failed or didn't meet satisfactory progress in a class during the 2021-2022 school year. We will be offering math, science and social studies via Apex learning platform. Students will need to attend in person and will be monitored by a Summer School teacher.

Tech It Up (Coding) (10:10a.m. -12:00 p.m.)

A general introduction to the basics of computer coding and problem solving. This class can also be adjusted for students with a more proficient understanding of coding to provide them rigor and an opportunity to expand their skills.
