



ABSTRACT



The abstract should be written in one paragraph and should be not more than 200 words. TNR, font size 11, single spacing. Follow the following pattern: General statement about the importance of the topic, gap in literature or discrepancies between theories and practices, purpose of study, method, main findings, and conclusion.



Keywords: Keyword one, keyword two, keyword three, keyword four, keyword five - TNR, 11, single spacing (no more than two lines)

Main headings – Font size 12, bold, UPPERCASE

Subheadings – Font size 12, Bold, Italic, Sentence case

The article should be between 4000-7000 words in two columns, 1 spaced, 12 point Times New Roman font, including references and appendices. Use no indent for the first paragraphs and do not leave a space between paragraphs.

The following paragraphs are indented first line 0.50cm. Top margin: 3 cm, Bottom margin: 3 cm, Right margin: 3 cm, Left margin: 4 cm. Using Mendeley for reference is recommended.

INTRODUCTION

An introduction consists of background of the study, literature review used as the theoretical and conceptual description, problems of the study, and objectives of the study. Don't put subheadings on introduction.

METHOD

This part contains the methods, data, source of data, data collecting technique, and data analysis technique. They are written in a narration not a listing. The statistical symbols are written based on the standardized ones.

FINDINGS AND DISCUSSION

It covers the findings and discussions of the study in which there is no separation within. It is expected that in the discussion, the author investigates his/her findings and refers back to the theoretical or empirical study which is written systematically, critically, and informatively.

CONCLUSION

Some points concluded from the subject discussed in the article.




Figure 1. Figure Caption
