



**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**MBYC / LYC Inter-Club Championship Day Regatta**  
**November 04 & 18, 2017**

**Organizing Authority is the Maui Boat & Yacht Club.**

**1. RULES:**

The race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020); the prescriptions of US Sailing; the prescriptions of HYRA; (except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions).

**2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY.**

- Eligibility for the Championship Trophy will be open to boats that have competed in 60% of all LYC AND MBYC Season Points Regattas AS WELL AS the Season Championship Regatta Day #2 November 18, 2017 which will be hosted by LYC.
- Points awarded at both events will be totaled to determine the winner of the Overall Trophy.

- HANDICAPS: Handicaps shall be in accordance with US Sailing-PHRF as modified by the LYC-MBYC.

**3. FEES**

The entry fee is \$40.00

**4. SCHEDULE**

Skippers Meeting by MB&YC's dock box near slip 25. The first warning will be at approximately 1155 hours. The warning signal for the second and third races will be approximately 10 minutes after the last boat finishes the preceding race. A total of three races are planned for each of the two days for a total of 6 races.

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** will be available at the skipper's meeting. **Please note that each day may have a different Sailing Instruction document at the discretion of the two clubs.**

**6. COURSE**

The races will be conducted offshore from the vicinity of Puamana / Launiupoko

**7. SCORING**

Scoring of the event shall be in accord with the PHRF Time-On-Distance Handicap system. The Low Point System will be used to score a yacht's regatta position as modified by HYRA. MBYC's scoring protocol can be accessed at <https://goo.gl/hmYtAu>
