(2018) ; Amnda et al. (2020) Eriyanti et al. (2020) & Maputra et al. (2020) thematic analysis with NVivo software is an effective way for a researcher to analyze interview results so that they can be seen in detail and depth.

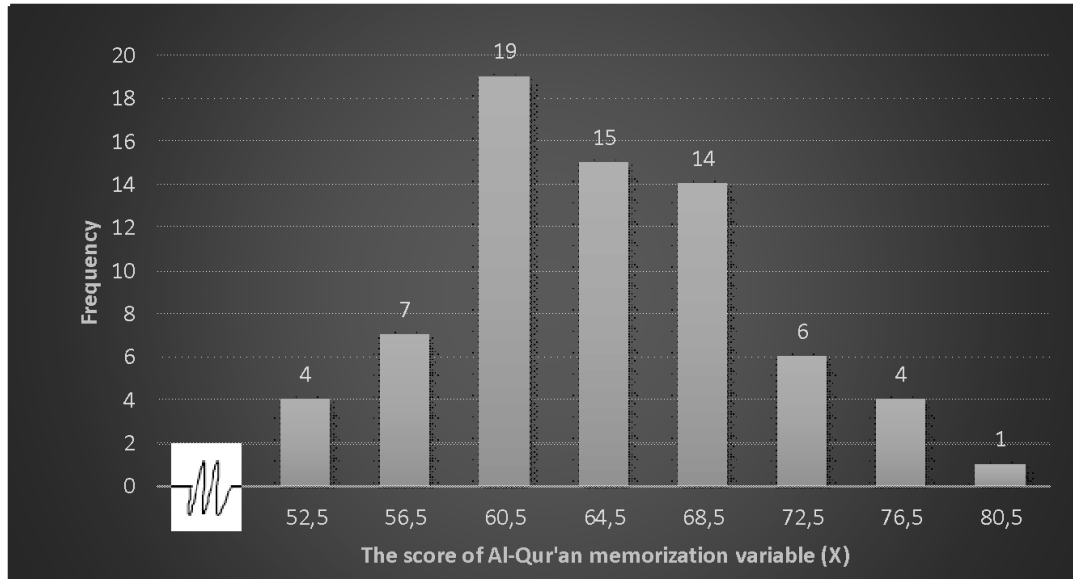
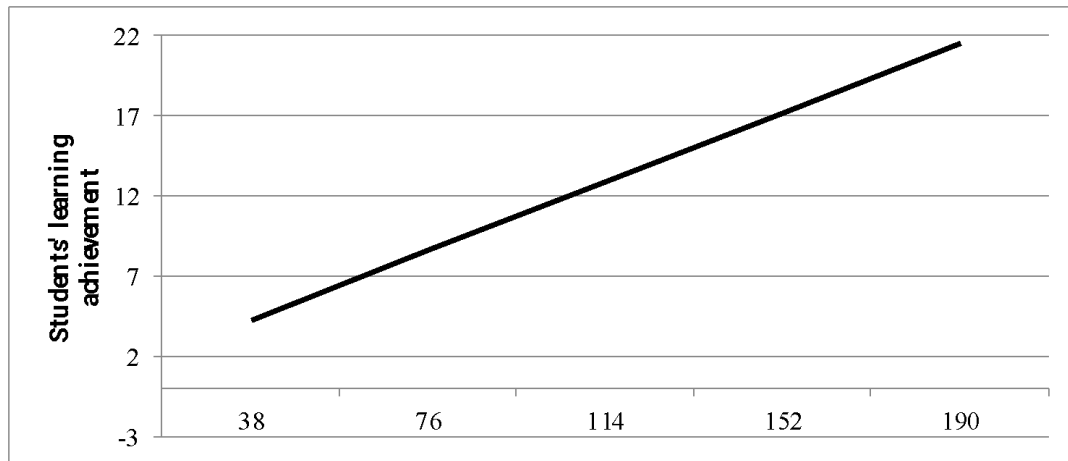


Figure : 1. The score s of Al-Qur'an memorization variable (X)
