## Thank you for helping facilitate the AP Language and Composition Defense of Learning portfolio presentations!

Dear Adjudication Panel:

You have a very important job today and/or tomorrow. As the impartial adjudicators of each group member's oral defense it is your responsibility to do the following:

- 1. Offer your **undivided audience** to each presenter.
- 2. Work to **maintain an open mind and unbiased point of view** in order to allow the argument and evidence offered to speak for itself.
- 3. Ask thoughtful and challenging questions to **push the thinking of each presenter** with the hope that they attain a new level of thinking and understanding of their own learning and work through rigorous dialogue and challenge to their thinking.
- 4. Engage in discussion at the end of each presentation to come to a summative grade using the following structure:

#### **STEP 1: ORAL DEFENSE**

i≪Student presented to panel of peers and mentors/teachers for 10 minutes i≪Student engaged in 5 minutes of Q & A and was able to answer all questions asked by panel.

#### **STEP 2: SCORING**

- Accept or deny proposed grade
- NOTE: If the proposal is *denied* the panel must propose an alternative grade.
