Part 1: WHOLE GROUP


<u>Topia Products</u>- Listed below are the items that need to be included in your group's Topia zone, listed by the project phase you completed them in. You can find these items by going to the # Benchmark Assignments section of Google Classroom and clicking on the phase the item is listed under here.

Once you have the item, you need to make it Topia ready. You do this by putting the

<u>Talking Points-</u> At exhibition your group will be stationed at your Topia Zone, and your job will be to guide visitors through your project products. Be ready to speak on all the points listed below

Phase 1 Item Requirements:

<u>Survey</u>: You must show survey responses to questions 1 and 3 for at least one member of your group. Responses can be on a billboard like the example below, or displayed in other ways if you prefer, but visitors must be able to read the responses in Topia



H.O.P.E. Story: Display 2-3 of your group's H.O.P.E stories. Add the link to the story to each image. The stories can be displayed by putting just the title and picture(s) on a scroll, like the example below, or displayed in other ways.

Phase 2B Requirements:

Infographic: If your group created an infographic, display it in topia. You may also live link to your infographic if you wish.



<u>Interview</u>: If your group conducted an interview, display it in topia. Insert the video or audio and have it playing in your zone OR insert a link to your interview video. Be sure to also include a sign describing who you interviewed
