Who Can Get Cellulite?

Although men can get it too, women are far more likely to suffer cellulite's visible effects, which can appear as "cottage cheese-like" dimpled areas on the thighs, hips, stomach, and buttocks. In most medical settings it's difficult to obtain exact figures, but it is estimated that cellulite occurs in 80% to 98% of women. (3) The amount of cellulite you have, and your predisposition to the condition is dependent on a number of factors, which include:

- Genetics
- Age
- Body Fat Percentage
- Hormonal Fluctuations
- Pregnancy
- Sedentary Lifestyle

Cellulite Treatment Options in Atlanta

Grades of Cellulite

Cellulite forms when fibrous tissue bands called *septae* tighten irregularly. These bands **pull down on the skin**, breaking down, and allowing the layer of fat beneath the skin to push upward and become more noticeable. (4) It can be categorized with a visual and physical **skin assessment** that includes testing its response to a "pinch test":

- Grade 0 No dimpling when pressure is applied.
- Grade 1 Dimpling when pressure is applied.
- Grade 2 Visible dimpling when standing, but not lying down.
- Grade 3 Dimpling is visible when both standing and lying down.

There are many different cosmetic **treatment options available** for cellulite, three of which Dr. Arslanian offers at his Atlanta location.

The Profound RF Microneedling System

Radiofrequency (RF) Microneedling is a cosmetic treatment that utilizes electromagnetic waves and thin needles to penetrate the skin and create a controlled skin injury, effectively **reducing the appearance of cellulite**. (11) **RF microneedling** can reduce the aesthetic appearance of cellulite in as little as one session, though the standard length of treatment is three or more sessions for more effective results. At his Atlanta clinic, Dr. Arslanian personally selects the **most effective treatments** for his patients.

Profound is a one-of-a-kind RF microneedling treatment. It is the first and only RF microneedling device with FDA clearance for face and body, with a 94% response rate for improvement in the appearance of cellulite. (5)

Qwo

If you're looking for an **alternative to RF microneedling** for your cellulite, consider **Qwo!** This **fast and easy** injection treatment is a less invasive way of fighting cellulite. The Qwo formulation is composed of collagenases clostridium histolyticum-aaes (CCH), a naturally occurring enzyme. During the treatment process, this enzyme is introduced to the targeted area. Over time, it releases the tension in the thick fibrous bands of tissue called septae where cellulite is present. Once these bands are broken, the fat cells in the tissue **redistribute evenly under the skin**, for more uniform, smoother-looking skin!

Sculptra

Used all over the body, but primarily used on the buttocks for cellulite, Sculptra is a safe, simple injection that adds volume to the treated area and **initiates fresh collagen production**. It is a poly-L-lactic acid substance that produces more voluminous tissue and smoothness in the skin. By **targeting the dimpled areas** of cellulite, Sculptra pinpoints and smooths out tissue, reducing the lumpy appearance and replacing it with a more defined contour.

Personal Consultation

Your safety and satisfaction is our main goal. At your personal consultation, Dr. Arslanian will assess your cellulite and outline the benefits of RF microneedling or another **corresponding treatment** to target the problem areas. At this time, he may photograph the areas for treatment for post-treatment comparison. You will be asked to give details about any **past cosmetic procedures** you have undergone, as well as provide a list of your current medications and brief medical history. Dr. Arslanian may have to alter some of your current medication regimens to **ensure your comfort, safety, and satisfaction** during and after your treatment.

Treatment Procedures

Profound RF Microneedling

During your **RF microneedling procedure**, Dr. Arslanian will use the Profound handheld device to apply medical-grade micro-needles to your skin. You will receive one of two RF microneedling treatments from Dr. Arslanian: the Profound Dermal Cartridge, which has a five-needle head, or the Profound SubQ Cartridge, which has seven needles. These ultrathin needles deliver radiofrequency energy **deep into the tissue**.

As a result of both treatments, your body will respond by producing more collagen. Additionally, the **radiofrequency waves emit heat** which boosts elastin and hyaluronic acid levels.

Combining these innovative technologies will result in the **smoother**, **healthier skin** that you desire!

Injectable Cellulite Treatments

The ways both Qwo and Sculptra are administered are similar. Qwo is a clear, odorless liquid that is injected through tiny needles into **cellulite-dimpled skin**. It targets the fibrous bands of tissue called septae, breaking them down and encouraging more even fat distribution in the area. Similarly, Sculptra can be injected into the treated area, but it addresses tissue volume and **decreases the appearance of cellulite** by adding more volume to the existing skin tissues.

Recovery & Results After RF Microneedling

Dr. Arslanian provides **complete skin resurfacing treatments and subdermal procedures for cellulite**, with minimal downtime. You will be able to return to most of your everyday activities immediately after most treatment sessions! Dr. Arslanian recommends you avoid any activities that will make you sweat profusely 24 hours after any cellulite reduction procedure. In the hours afterward the treated area may be sensitive, and with microneedling, you may notice small healing scabs at the points of entry into your skin. Generally speaking, you must make sure you **keep the treated areas moisturized**, stay out of the sun, and apply sunscreen if sun exposure is unavoidable.

Your skin will generate fresh collagen and build a new, smoother layer in the days and weeks to come. To conserve the aesthetic appearance of your **younger**, **more vibrant skin**, Dr. Arslanian advises all patients to maintain a healthy lifestyle and consistent weight after their treatment. How Can RF Needling Get Rid of My Cellulite?

Radiofrequency microneedling is a skin resurfacing treatment that can **reduce cellulite** by creating micro injuries that the body responds to by producing more collagen fibers. The effect of these newly created healing fibers mean that the cellulite-affected area is smoothed, for a more **aesthetic skin texture**.

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
