Students who earn a M.A. degree qualify for the Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association, the Speech-Language Pathology Services Credential from the California Commission for Teacher Credentialing, and the State of California Licensure in Speech-Language Pathology.</i></p> <p>In the CSULB catalog, it clearly states the requirements for the <b>California Speech-Language Pathology Service Credential</b>. Candidates must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Complete the: <a href="#">Speech-Language Pathology, M.A.</a></li> <li>2. Complete the following courses: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <a href="#">EDSP 350 - Introduction to Teaching the Exceptional Individual</a> (3 units)- Students must complete this course before the first semester begins. Each student must submit a transcript and course syllabus showing completion of the coursework, which will be further verified by the Graduate Advisor during the first semester. The Graduate Advisor conducts an equivalency check using the course syllabus.</li> <li>● <a href="#">SLP 575 - Educational Topics in Speech-Language Pathology</a> (3 units) - Required course for all MA students</li> <li>● <a href="#">SLP 686A - Public School Practicum in Speech-Language Pathology</a> (5 units)- Required course for all MA students</li> </ul> </li> </ol> <p>Upon completion of the program and posting of the master's degree, a credential analyst will conduct a final evaluation and confirm that the candidate has completed all the requirements prior to credential recommendation.</p>
