Greetings Emmaus Community!

Summer is gone and the fall walks are approaching quickly. Both walks are full, so I'm grateful to GOD for bringing just the right Pilgrims and Team Members together. Once we experience Send Off, the real work begins for those of us not working on the walk. What's our job once letters, agape, and signing up to help with meals is all done?

Prayer!

We know that GOD moves through prayer. Jesus said in Matt 6:6, "But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you." Because we experienced GOD on our walks, it is time to pay it forward once again. It is through this behind-the-scenes work of prayer that the Pilgrims hear clearly what GOD is saying to them. Their eyes will be open, and they will see Jesus and HIS great healing love.

Many of us have signed up for a 30-minute slot to pray. That's wonderful! There may be open slots if you haven't had the chance yet. But that 30-minute segment is just the beginning. It's the going behind closed doors, just us and GOD, where the power flows. Listen for GOD to call you to prayer during these two walks. Be ready to be "on call" for when more prayer power is needed. If you wake up in the night, pray for the Pilgrims and Team. If you feel a nudge from the Holy Spirit during your kids' soccer game, pray. If you are in Walmart and you begin to wonder how the walks are going, pray. If you attend candlelight or remember your own, pray on Sunday. GOD will bring it to mind. Let's say YES to GOD when HE calls us to pray. We want Jesus' power to flow mightily and lives to be transformed by the Holy Spirit. We all can work the walks through prayer.

Other ways to serve are to show up at sendoff (7:00 p.m.), candlelight (7:30 p.m.), and closing (4:00 p.m.); make some homemade snack agape, sign up to serve a meal, and bring table agape (100) or pillow agape (30). There will always be unexpected things that happen. Let's "be prepared in and out of season" (2 Timothy 4:2), as we represent and present GOD to this broken world.


