<u>Stockyard Drawl</u> is a Chicago-based Americana and bluegrass trio that blends traditional roots music with contemporary songwriting and bold improvisation. With a sound deeply influenced by bluegrass, folk, Chicago blues, and Irish-American Celtic traditions, the band delivers a dynamic mix of intricate instrumentation, tight vocal harmonies, and compelling storytelling.

Formed by <u>Brendan Forrest</u> (guitar, vocals), <u>Seán Carolan</u> (upright bass), and <u>Ben Zorn</u> (fiddle, mandolin), <u>Stockyard</u> <u>Drawl</u> combines technical mastery with raw, emotional depth, setting them apart in the modern Americana and bluegrass scene. Their music seamlessly weaves driving rhythms, expressive melodies, and exploratory arrangements, resulting in a sound that is both timeless and forward-thinking.

About the Artists

<u>Brendan Forrest</u> is a rising force in the folk and Americana music scene, known for his technical flatpicking, heartfelt songwriting, and genre-defying approach. His debut album, <u>Daydreaming Music Fiend</u>, received critical acclaim for its unique fusion of country, folk rock, jazz, and psychedelic influences. Forrest has collaborated with a diverse range of esteemed musicians, including 2x GRAMMY® Award-winner <u>Dominick Leslie</u>, <u>Allie Kral</u>, IBMA winners <u>George Jackson</u> and <u>Jake Stargel</u>, and jazz guitarist <u>Bobby Broom</u>, further showcasing his versatility and depth as an artist.

<u>Seán Carolan</u>, a Chicago-based bassist and multi-instrumentalist, has toured across North and South America and Europe, performing Irish traditional, American folk, and improvisational music. A founding member of <u>Mungion</u>, he has also collaborated with <u>Byron Stripling</u>, <u>Bobby Floyd</u>, <u>Trinity Irish Dance Company</u>, and <u>Victor Wooten</u>, among others.

<u>Ben Zorn</u> is a multi-instrumentalist from Chicago's northwest side with deep ties to the Midwest folk scene. A versatile performer on guitar, bass, mandolin, banjo, fiddle, and ukulele, Zorn has performed with the <u>Local Wildlife Band</u>, studied bluegrass at Davis & Elkins College, and played fiddle with <u>River Valley Rangers</u> at <u>Blue Ox Music Festival 2023</u>.
