Jewellery in school

For Health and Safety reasons, we would prefer children not to wear ear rings. If they cannot be removed, please ensure that they are covered with plasters.

Watches

We do not allow smart watches or similar in school, as they are a distraction. Analogue watches can be worn in KS2. If your child arrives in a smart watch and to ensure that they concentrate on their work, we will ask the child to remove it and it will be returned at home time.

Hair Styles

Governors are very clear about expectations for hairstyles and have set a policy that is applicable to everyone in school and Nursery.

“There can be **NO hair colouring, stripes or undercuts**. Longer hairstyles need to be tied back with a bobble or a hair band. We do not permit fashion cuts, where hair is shaved at the sides but a longer length elsewhere (similar to an undercut).

If your child asks for a fashion haircut, it is parent’s responsibility to explain that this is school policy and good preparation for when they transfer to High School. (See local High School policy below). The children need to understand that these are the school rules to be followed and respected.

This is taken from the School Prospectus, which can also be found on the School Website:

8.14 Hair

These rules apply to both girls and boys. Extreme hairstyles are not permitted nor are hair colourings. If any child arrives in school sporting a style, which is considered by the Head Teacher to be extreme or a fashion haircut, he/she may be excluded for a period to facilitate suitable adjustments. We do not permit undercuts.

These hair accessories are deemed acceptable for both boys and girls. Please check your child’s hair regularly for infestation. For safety and hygiene reasons, long hair should be tied back.”

Year 6 walking to school or walking home

We do not expect there to be many children arriving by themselves or walking home this term, as it is still very early in the year for Year 6 to be doing this on their own. There may be one or two very local children who may have authorisation to do this. A form is available on request. This would need to be completed. Mrs Amos would then consider the request and let you know if this is acceptable.

Medication

Please ensure your child's up to date Medication is in school as soon as possible. It has come to our attention that parents of children with Epipen, can download an APP which alerts you as to when you need to replace them. This sounds like a really good idea!

Medicines in School

Mrs Smith liaises with parents who need a care plan, when there is an ongoing medical need (allergies etc.), to ensure that the correct medical provision is in place.

We do understand that sometimes children need medication for a particular ailment, who are well enough to be in school. For example; eye drops, Piriton, antibiotics. We are happy to administer these, provided the school medical form is completed and is handed into the office staff with the medication. We cannot administer medication without this form. We would not expect to administer Calpol to keep a temperature down. In that instance children would not be well enough for school. It is not the Office Staff who will administer these medicines, but Mrs Amos. The medical form will be on the website under Newsletters.
