### Location

The course is adjacent to the Kachel Fieldhouse, where the start/finish lines are in the intramural fields—marked "Club Soccer Field and Intramural Field #3" on the <u>campus map</u>.

## **Parking**

\*Spectators must park in Lot 11 (Williams Center) and Lot 24 (Stadium) ONLY. They cannot park in Lot 22 (Baseball) or Lots 7, 8, or 9 near the Tennis Courts as these are designated Campus parking areas for residence hall students or commuters, and parking permits are required.
