Lesson Plan: *Lesson 1 Young Women & The Fight Against Climate Change*

Numeracy Activity: WOMEN IN STEM - Circle Graphs

A study titled "Persistence and representation of women in STEM programs" followed the university careers of nearly 130,000 students to compare the programs chosen by women and men.

For the following questions, round (if necessary) to the tenths place value

1. In this study there were approximately 130,000 people that attended first year university and 55,000 were men. What percentage of the students attending their first year were women?

2. Many of the students decided to choose a career path in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics). There were 22,500 men and 17,500 women. What was the total percentage of the students studying STEM were women?



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3. The study identified how many students participated in each field of STEM.
