- (1) Connecting students with Services and Resources across the university
- (2) NYU connect is a tool, reporting system, a hub that connects faculty, students, and advisors in one space, when faculty use NYU Connect and raise a concern about a student. Whatever the faculty says in that note will go to the academic advisor. The advisor would then reach out to the student. NYU connect is like the student's file. Student Services will be alert of the activities.
- (3) Link on you class or grade roster in Albert or access via NYU home
 - Raise a flag
 - Inform a student's academic advisor(s), when a student needs support (i.e. academic issues, attendance concerns, low grades).

- Raise a flag if you know of student financial concerns. Alert Teresa Gargiulo and Linda Nicholas.
- Send kudos to students
 - Recognize students for their performance in the classroom, on their assignments, or in extra-curriculars.
- Receive follow up communications
 - Know that your concern has been addressed, so you can be sure your students are receiving the help they need.
- Complete progress surveys
 - You'll receive an email asking for feedback on student performance at specific points in the semester
