Last meeting: August 1, 2024

1. Yesterday, the Dept. of Health reported 480 new Covid cases with a 7-day average of 72 cases and 8 deaths for that weekly period. The State is still seeing the impact of the recent surge in Covid cases. I encourage you to stay up to date on your Covid shots as well as your flu shots. If you are over 60, there is now a vaccine for Respiratory Sincytial (sin-SISH-uhl) Virus (RSV) which is also a good idea to get.

A new, updated 2024-2025 Covid vaccine has been approved for use. This vaccine is not meant to prevent every Covid variant; rather, the aim is to protect against severe illness, hospitalization and death. They also restore and enhance protection from previous shots, which has declined over time.
