#### **MAST Window 1 Complete**

TFES students in grades 3-5 have recently completed the first window of the new statewide test, MAST (Montana Aligned to Standards Through-Year). During this testing window students completed both 3-5 math and 3-5 ELA "testlets". The next window opens on January 13th. It is imperative that parents communicate any long term absences or vacations that are planned during these windows. When kids miss school unannounced, they may not be able to complete all of the assigned tests, negatively impacting the District's completion rates. #### -Little Wolves Basketball Season News/Notes

Basketball season is kicking off and that means we are getting closer to Little Wolves Basketball! Little Wolves Basketball is a long standing tradition here in Three Forks and we are excited about the 24-25 season of the program. Little Wolves Basketball Director, Trevor Aune will once again be leading the program. Trevor is a Three Forks graduate that played Little Wolves himself a few years back. We are excited to have Trevor back to assist with continuing this great tradition. Below you will find some information about the Little Wolves program and some important dates for parents and participants.

Little Wolves Basketball is a FREE developmental program for boys and girls who attend grades 3-6 at Three Forks School. The program is split into two age divisions, grades 3 and 4, as well as grades 5 and 6. The purpose of the program is to provide an opportunity for participants to learn the fundamentals of the game during practice and apply those skills in some competitive games. Teams will compete during the halftime of both boys and girls Varsity games as well as on Saturday mornings. The season will wrap up with a Jamboree tournament that will take place on February 22nd.

If you have a son or daughter that attends grades 3-6 at Three Forks School and is interested in participating, please have them complete and return a player waiver form (FORM LINK) to the elementary or middle school office. Forms MUST be returned by December 12th for students to be able to participate and to be guaranteed a team jersey.
