
Thanks to your kindness and generosity, we were able to provide support to children and families in need, showing once again the power of our community when we come together for a great cause.

Fourth and Fifth Grade in SEL



In fourth and fifth grade in SEL, students have been exploring the concept of perspective and what it means to take a step in someone else's shoes. Students have been learning how seeing things from another person's point of view helps build empathy—an essential social skill. Our fourth graders in SEL completed their "Magnifying Glass" project, where they examined zoomed-in images to practice shifting their perspective and recognizing the bigger picture. An example of a magnified image our fourth graders examined is pictured on the right! Meanwhile, our fifth graders in SEL became "Perspective Detectives," using optical illusions to challenge their thinking and discover multiple ways of seeing the same thing! Some examples of our optical illusions our fifth graders are on the left!


