


# Save the Date!

## YOU'RE INVITED TO JOIN US ON A FLOAT DOWN THE CLACKAMAS RIVER



The purpose of this year's watershed tour is to provide our elected officials and interested citizens a different perspective of the Clackamas River by floating down the River from Carver Park to Clackamette Park.

Along the way we will see stormwater outfalls, two of Clackamas River Basin Council's restoration projects, lower river tributaries that flow into the Clackamas, a railroad crossing, and at all four of our lower river drinking water intake structures. It should provide you with an unique perspective of this amazing river that we get our drinking water from.
