Families,

I cannot believe we only have two months of school left this year. There have been many things to celebrate this school year, and becoming part of the Chagrin community has been great.

This time of year provides much excitement for all of the end-of-the-year activities. As we transition to the end of the year, I am providing an update with some important information.

END-OF-COURSE EXAMS

Beginning April 19th, we will be conducting our state testing. Below are all the test dates for this year's End of Course (EOC) state exam. All students taking EOCs will be notified of their testing location and must report to that location for the normal start of the school day (7:40 am). Students should bring their charged Chromebook to the testing location for their exams. Additionally, for any mathematics EOC, students should also bring their calculators.

For the two weeks of testing, 4/17-4/21 and 4/24-4/28, we will be on an 8-period schedule.

Students who do not have scheduled EOCs will be on a delayed schedule. That information is listed below.

We will be running our regular transportation schedule. Students who are bus riders may take the bus at their regularly scheduled time. If students are not taking an exam and arrive at school before 9:40am, they must report to the Commons.
