

## Names of God

**El Ohim:** Creator God.

### **Genesis 1:14**

<sup>14</sup> *And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years:*

He is The Creator and Possessor of Heaven and Earth. It is a reference to Gods power and might. "You alone are God= El Ohim. You are describing unto Him His power and might. Say it in an affectionate way: "Oh my Lord, my God, you are El Ohim- see what you have done! Even The Heavens declare your glory! The sky, the moon, the stars, the sun, the galaxy, the whole firmament shows forth your handiwork. NO ONE can do what You, El Ohim, have done!" God creates a way out of nothing!

**Adonai** (Ad-don-nye): Master of everything seen and unseen. It refers to the Lordship of God.

### **Malachi 1:6**

<sup>6</sup> *A son honoureth his father, and a servant his master: if then I be a father, where is mine honour? and if I be a master, where is my fear? saith the LORD of hosts unto you, O priests, that despise my name. And ye say, Wherein have we despised thy name?*

**Jehovah or Yahweh:** Lord God the I AM.

Tell them I am Jehovah Yahweh, I AM that I AM whether you like it or not. I am The Creator and Maker of Heaven and Earth. I am GOD!!!

### **Genesis 2:4**

<sup>4</sup> *These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,*

*Exodus 3:14*

<sup>14</sup> *And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.*

**Jehovah Mekkadishkem** (May-ka-dish-kem): "I am the LORD thy sanctifier."

He is the Lord who sanctifies us. He makes us Holy and Pure like Him. He is the Lord of the Sabbath. He cleanses us from unclean spirits and their ways.

### **Exodus 31:13**

<sup>13</sup> *Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that I am the LORD that doth sanctify you.*

**Jehovah Rohi:** "The LORD is my Shepherd." Psalm 23.

"Daddy you are My Jehovah Rohi- It is you who leads me to green pastures. I shall not want or lack any good thing. You don't lead me in brown pastures. I shall not lack because of you Daddy!!!" He refreshes us, leads, guides and protects us. We shall not lack spiritual security; we shall not lack on this earth. He will lead us all the days of our lives. His green pastures mean peace and harmony- nothing outside of what glorifies God.

**Jehovah Shammah:** "The LORD is there" or "the LORD is present."

The Lord is there with you. He is with me. He is my only present God. He is with me always. He is my unseen guest. He is listening to me and acting for me.

**Ezekiel 48:35**

<sup>35</sup> *It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be, The LORD is there.*

**Jehovah Rapha** (Raw-fah): "The Lord is my healer" or "I AM the LORD who heals you."

God doesn't throw His healing out for nothing. "Daddy you are my Rapha. Lord, please forgive me, cleanse me and heal me. Your word says if we diligently seek you, heed you and do what is good in your sight that you will heal me for you are the Lord my God who heals me. Please help me do what is good in your sight Daddy I love you."

**Exodus 15:26**

<sup>26</sup> *And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.*

**Jehovah Tsidkenu** (Chit-Kanu): The LORD our Righteousness.

He is our righteousness, our salvation. Salvation is deliverance from demons who want to take us to hell. He wants to equip us and empower us with His salvation. When we have a right relationship with Him, we have safety for our spirit, soul and body members. He makes me right with Him, to have right words, right thoughts and right actions.

**Jeremiah 23:6**

<sup>6</sup> *In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.*

**Jehovah Jireh** (Jee-Ray): "The LORD will Provide" or "The LORD is my Provider."

Abraham almost sacrificed his only son and God let it go as far as it did and then last minute came to rescue Isaac. When you think all hope is gone, He comes to save you because your eyes are upon Him. Our hearts trust in Him and are glad.

### **Genesis 22:4**

<sup>4</sup> Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off.

**Jehovah Nissi:** "The LORD is my banner, my victory, my strength and my miracle!"

He's all that we have to trust in. Whatever circumstances we find ourselves in He is our victory, strength and power!!!! No matter how the enemy beats you or pushes you, get on your knees and say Daddy you are my strength and my banner, my victory over thousands and and billions of demons!!! "LORD I have no way of winning this battle, but because you are my Jehovah Nissi-my banner, my victory, my strength, my miracle- I will win! We spread Him out and make Him big!

### **Exodus 17:15**

<sup>15</sup> And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it Jehovah Nissi:

**Jehovah Shalom:** "The LORD is my peace."

When the enemy fills you with fearful thoughts, say, "The Lord is my peace oh enemy." Worship Him in your mind and He will give you peace.

### **Judges 6:23-24**

**Jehovah Sabbaoth** (Sab-bah-oath): "The LORD of Hosts."

### **Isaiah 6:1-3**

In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the LORD sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.<sup>2</sup> Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.<sup>3</sup> And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.

The LORD who is the God of ALL the angels, whether holy or demonic.

**Jehovah Gmolah** (Gæmole-ah): "God of Vengeance."

God doesn't make mistakes. He is always right- He pays back His enemies.

### **Jeremiah 51:6**

<sup>6</sup> Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this is the time of the LORD's vengeance; he will render unto her a recompence.

**El-Elyon:** "God Most High"

There is no one above Him!

### **Genesis 14:17-20**

<sup>17</sup> And the king of Sodom went out to meet him after his return from the slaughter of Chedorlaomer, and of the kings that were with him, at the valley of Shaveh, which is the king's dale.<sup>18</sup> And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.<sup>19</sup> And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth:<sup>20</sup> And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.

**El-Roi (Roy):** "I am the LORD who sees"

The LORD sees our situation! He sees the way we think, feel, and act. We cannot hide anything from Him. We cannot presume or assume he doesn't see our suffering. The moment someone hurts you or cheats you say, "Lord, you are my El-Roi, your the God who see's- please intervene for me for your holy glories sake."

### **Genesis 16:11-13**

<sup>11</sup> And the angel of the LORD said unto her, Behold, thou art with child and shalt bear a son, and shalt call his name Ishmael; because the LORD hath heard thy affliction

<sup>12</sup> And he will be a wild man; his hand will be against every man, and every man's hand against him; and he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren.

<sup>13</sup> And she called the name of the LORD that spake unto her, Thou God seest me: for she said, Have I also here looked after him that seeth me?

**El-Shaddai** (Shad-dye): "The LORD God Almighty."

The LORD is God Almighty. There is no one mighty like Him. He has complete power. He is omnipotent- having unlimited power and able to do anything. He is powerful, supreme, preeminent-surpassing all others. He is distinguished as the best. He is chief, the most excellent, foremost, renowned, supreme, finest, outstanding, famous, celebrated GOD!

**Psalm 91:1** He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

**Genesis 17:1** And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.

**Nahum 1:5** <sup>5</sup> The mountains quake at him, and the hills melt, and the earth is burned at his presence, yea, the world, and all that dwell therein.

### **Deuteronomy 4:25-39**

<sup>25</sup> When thou shalt beget children, and children's children, and ye shall have remained long in the land, and shall corrupt yourselves, and make a graven image, or the likeness of any thing, and shall do evil in the sight of the LORD thy God, to provoke him to anger:<sup>26</sup> I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that ye shall soon utterly perish from off the land whereunto ye go over Jordan to possess it; ye shall not prolong your days upon it, but shall utterly be destroyed.<sup>27</sup> And the LORD shall scatter you among the nations, and ye shall be left few in number among the heathen, whither the LORD shall lead you.<sup>28</sup> And there ye shall serve gods, the work of men's hands, wood and stone, which neither see, nor hear, nor eat, nor smell.<sup>29</sup> But if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul.<sup>30</sup> When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days, if thou turn to the LORD thy God, and shalt be obedient unto his voice,<sup>31</sup> (For the LORD thy God is a merciful God;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them.<sup>32</sup> For ask now of the days that are past, which were before thee, since the day that God created man upon the earth, and ask from the one side of heaven unto the other, whether there hath been any such thing as this great thing is, or hath been heard like it? <sup>33</sup> Did ever people hear the voice of God speaking out of the midst of the fire, as thou hast heard, and live? <sup>34</sup> Or hath God assayed to go and take him a nation from the midst of another nation, by temptations, by signs, and by wonders, and by war, and by a mighty hand, and by a stretched out arm, and by great terrors, according to all that the LORD your God did for you in Egypt before your eyes? <sup>35</sup> Unto thee it was shewed, that thou mightest know that the LORD he is God; there is none else beside him.<sup>36</sup> Out of heaven he made thee to hear his voice, that he might instruct thee: and upon earth he shewed thee his great fire; and thou heardest his words out of the midst of the fire.<sup>37</sup> And because he loved thy fathers,

therefore he chose their seed after them, and brought thee out in his sight with his mighty power out of Egypt;<sup>38</sup> To drive out nations from before thee greater and mightier than thou art, to bring thee in, to give thee their land for an inheritance, as it is this day.<sup>39</sup> Know therefore this day, and consider it in thine heart, that the LORD he is God in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath: there is none else.
