Chairs

To comply with the minimum requirements for a DSE chair as defined in the Schedule to the DSE Regulations, the seat should be adjustable in height and it's back adjustable in both height and tilt and that the chair should be stable and allow the user easy freedom of movement and a comfortable position.

Adjustable arms also ensure that chairs can be used suitably.

Desks

By DSE regulations the surface width of the desk should be no less than 1200mm, with an optimum width of 1600mm. The arrangement of items on the desk top/worksurface should take into account the normal working area to avoid over stretching. Desks are recommended to not be narrower than 60cm.

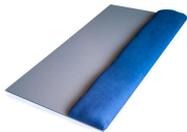
