- Be sure your answers clearly reflect the key concepts presented in the materials

Your goal is to show that you have engaged with the readings and videos and can apply what you've learned to your discussion responses.

Important Notice: AI Policy

I want to take time to clarify my expectations regarding written assignments, discussions, and any other work you turn in my courses going forward.

AI is a great tool to help with brainstorming or reviewing concepts, but **may not be used as your final answer and copy and pasted**. When you use AI in your work, I see many students with the exact same answers word for word! If I think the work is not in your own words, I will simply respond in the comments that I believe this is AI work and will give you a **0 on the work turned in**.

Going forward, each question should be answered in a complete paragraph that clearly demonstrates you are engaging with the assigned readings and videos. Your responses should go beyond brief or surface-level statements and instead explain ideas fully, using specific concepts, examples, or details drawn directly from the course materials.

Question 1

Define the term **Fast Fashion**.

Despite people knowing about sweatshops, why do we as consumers continue to purchase from companies that do not provide their workers with adequate working conditions? (*Refer to videos*)

Question 5

Would the modern-day fashion industry survive without sweatshops? Explain in detail. (*Refer to videos*)

Question 6

Explain **Implicit Bias**. What does it mean? How can we reduce Implicit Bias? (*Refer to Chapter 3*)

Question 7

Clothing views need to change: Clothing you purchase should be something to hold onto and value. Clothing pieces should be treasured. You should take great care of your clothing pieces. Your clothing should last for many years. Your clothing should represent your personal style, NOT current trends of the time! Instead of buying many low-quality clothing items each year (average is 68 items a year), you should buy a few good quality pieces each year.
