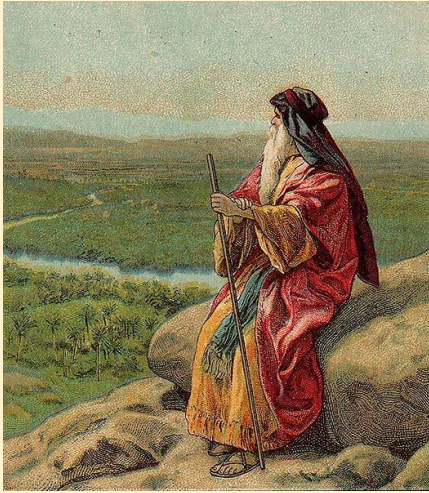


A CROWN TO CAST
