Cons:

Tether (USDT) or TON (Telegram token) are preferred, but we can discuss other variants~

Boosty (no PayPal, sorry)

Pros:

+ customer oftenly familiar with that analog of Patreon

Cons:

- only bank cards can be used since ~April 2024
- sometimes issues with big transactions can appear (fixable*)

*Fixing possible issues:

1) issues with big transactions can appear - can be treated by dividing total amount by multiple 100 USD transactions.

Desc: Boosty is the russian Patreon analog made in 2019, with the ability to donate to a creator or to make a one-time-purchase post for payment.

Hipolink (technical work for restoring PayPal is in progress)

Pros:

+ customer can use PayPal here? (Works 50/50~)

Cons:

- <u>sometime</u> issues with big transactions can appear (fixable)

Desc: Hipolink appears after Boosty stopped accepting PayPal as payment method.

Fixing possible issues:

1) issues with big transactions can appear - can be treated by dividing total amount by multiple 100 USD transactions.

EasyStart (invoice method) and EasyBusy (marketplace method) (PayPal is working here)

Pros:

- + PayPal is working here
- + stability of platform

Cons:

- <u>invoice method</u>: customer need to write his REAL card and cardholder info for a security checking (I don't see this info, all is confidential)
- <u>marketplace method</u>: you will need to make "freelance task" (see details in links below)

Desc: Easy Start - platform made in 2021, it provides the ability of payment customer-to-freelancer via email invoice. Plus, they make freelance marketplace where you can safely use PayPal as payment method~ I collected data - lots of my colleagues use this platform as their main payment method - it's trusted~

Concern about need of use REAL data:

Please be assured that your personal details are solely for processing your order. I operate with strict discretion, and your privacy is my utmost priority.

NOT LISTED IN FORM / "LAST CHANCE" METHODS

PayPal intermediator (15% fees)

Pros:

+ Direct transfer from PayPal mail to PayPal mail

Cons:

- 15% of fees to total sum of order

Desc: Last chance if anything else didn't work~

Russian banks transaction

Pros:

+ Direct transfer (if it's possible for you)

Cons:

 until almost all russian banks under sanctions, it works <u>only for</u> <u>residents of Russia</u> or who has friend/intermediate to process transaction

Desc: Tinkoff, Alfa, Sberbank, etc. In times like these, it makes sense to have every possible path, doesn't it?
