Fact RVW #45 failed to activate the Script-Check mode on their car before returning to the race track after re-rezzing procedures.

Infringement Breach of Section 3 - Qualifying. "All cars must be set into Script-Check mode (green hover text) for the remainder of the event starting with qualifying."

Decision Warning with No further Action

Reason The point of the rule is to ensure that drivers are racing with zero scripts attached during qualifying and the race. Car #45 was asked to activate Script-Check mode and they did so immediately upon request. At no point did officials think that this was done intentionally, and understood that it was very clearly an oversight during a stressful situation. Furthermore, this rule is largely for lag reduction and driver 'peace of mind' ever since Linden Lab added a script function to block outside scripts from being able to affect a vehicle's momentum. This function has been in all FVA cars for several seasons now.

A revision of the rule will be implemented to include clear expectations and potential consequences for future infractions during both qualifying and race sessions.
