Printing a Book on LibreTexts

LibreTexts provides easy to order books through Lulu, with LibreTexts designed cover and formatting

Process

- Go to [LibreTexts](#)
- Choose Explore the Libraries
 - Pick your desired library
- Select bookshelves
- Select your desired bookshelf (mostly related to academic disciplines)
- Select your desired book
- From the drop down menu in the top right, hover over Downloads
- Click on Buy Paper Copy
- Complete order
 - Choose quantity
 - Choose cover
 - Chose black and white or color
 - Choose shipping option
- Checkout

Printing Your Book Through Lulu.com

Before you start the process of printing your book:

- Have your PDF ready without cover (be sure to provide attribution for your cover image, if used)
 - Tips:
 - Be sure you've converted anything that is formatted for digital access for those using only the print version (for instance: URLs won't be clickable)
 - To avoid getting an error message about embedded text, print the PDF to PDF.
 - If you want to build your book to be published, here are some resources they provide:

- Have your image for cover creation ready (be sure you have provided attribution for your image in the interior of your book)

- If you prefer to build your cover first, you can use their template for reference (it's a PDF)
- Hint: If you are looking for images, you can try unsplash.com (for example, search for pattern to find images for the centered tile or spine image options)

Register to create a Lulu.com account

- Requires name, email, preferred currency, preferred language, and password

Choose Create Print Book

- Start Page
 - Select a Goal: Choose Publish Your Book
 - Tip: unless you have or want to get ISBN, unselect Global Distribution
 - Provide Book Details
 - Title, language, and if desired, category
- Copyright Page
 - Add Copyright and Contributor Information
 - Title, subtitle (optional), Edition and Edition Statement (optional)
 - Add contributors by role and name
 - Choose copyright
 - OER would be some rights reserved (CC BY)
 - If desired, can then check boxes for NC, SA, and ND
 - Optional to also include Copyright Holder Name and Copyright Year
 - If you unselected Global Distribution an ISBN is not required
- Design Page
 - Upload PDF file (ensure images are as high quality as possible and that your fonts are all embedded (the reason I suggest printing your PDF to PDF)
 - The book specifications should autofill when your file is fully uploaded
 - Choose your interior color
 - I recommend "Color Standard" unless you have nothing in color in your book
 - Choose your paper type
 - I used 60# white
 - Choose your book binding
 - I recommend Paperback
 - Design your cover
 - I recommend, creating a cover
 - Chose title and contributor/s that will go on the cover (
 - Create description for back cover (not required)
 - Choose a template, upload the photo, select the color scheme
 - You can upload a cover (complicated to get proper file, they do provide a template in a PDF for reference)
 - Confirm using the cover (click on Use This Cover)
 - Preview the book and download the files

- Details Page
 - Provide description (will show up when people go to link to purchase)
 - Can provide optional contributor notes (not sure where this shows up though)
 - Can provide table of contents to help the search function (not viewable)
 - Pick the bookstore category
 - And BISAC category
 - Provide keywords
 - Choose your audience
 - Place to select if includes explicit content
- Pricing and Payee Page
 - Set price – if anything in the book in NC, you cannot make money of the book
 - I recommend choosing fixed price
 - Set price of book for each currency to match the minimum price
 - This results in no profit to you for the book
 - If you profit, you don't need a payee
- Review Page
 - Will have you confirm each of the following (can click Revise or use top buttons ot
 - Specifications and files
 - Copyright and book details
 - Book details
 - Pricing and payees
 - Select retail options
 - If you want anyone to be able to find and order it, choose general access and publish the Lulu Bookstore
 - If you would prefer to have to provide the link to purchase it, you can choose that option instead
 - You can now order copies of your book, share the URL for others to purchase it, and have others find your book on their own (unless you choose not to send it to the Lulu Bookstore)

Shipping costs begin at \$3.99 for 10-12 business days (I ordered 5 books with the cheapest shipping option for \$6.99)
