**Treasurer Report:** Revenue was higher in Aug. than September. They fit with the average monthly donations of previous months according to donation patterns. Expenses were higher than previous months. In "unusual" expenses in August we paid for the Website and domain renewals, \$401.17. There was a check that was placed in the Treasurer's budget because I don't know where it was sent, only the amount, \$144.14. All other expenses in August were in line with previous months. In September we reimbursed Corrections for the books ordered back in Aug, \$420.39, the DCM for printing and travel expenses, \$470.05, added the Alt DCM budget line item, all other expenses were in line with previous months. Area of concern, when the old account was shut down and the new account was created we are missing \$186.06. I have reached out to the bank to see if we can get a September 2023 statement from the old account in order to identify where these funds went. I will update in Oct. The Operating Fund "Excess Surplus" is now at \$951.19.

**Treatment:** We are averaging 4-6 volunteers weekly and have successfully continued a chairperson rotation which has been very helpful. Eastside How donated some big books. We have located a cabinet to keep the big books. We are working to get in touch with area treatment chairs to communicate with other districts about what they are doing.

**CPC/PI:** 1) Harlem High School – An AA talk was arranged to be given to the Freshman students in health class at Harlem High School in December. 2) Winnebago High School Talk – An AA talk will be given to Winnebago High School students in their health class during the units on drugs and alcohol in October 2023. 3) High Schools, et. al. – Other high schools were contacted but no attempts were made to return my calls. 4) CPC/PI Zoom Meeting – On October 4 - Tom attended a PI/CPC zoom workshop where discussion centered on CPC/PI Digital Outreach and Outreach to Healthcare, Courts and Probation. 5) PI Assistance – Eric is assisting Tom with distribution of pamphlets to the various libraries, clinics, etc. in District 70. 6) CPC/PI for 2024 – Leonard from the HOW Group has expressed interest in taking over CPC/PI for the next rotation. Tom and Leonard have been meeting to discuss the tasks at a hand and Leonard has attended one of the presentations to the St. Anthony Nursing Students. The position is 80% sales and 20% AA and would best be filled by someone with extensive business and professional experience and who is connected within the community. Leonard has these qualifications and I believe he would serve the role very well with Tom giving him guidance at the beginning of a potential term

We had 65 calls this month. HOW asked if they could "merge" with the District Phone - this would mean listing the District Number under the HOW group on schedules. It has been previously decided we won't list the District Number that way to avoid confusion for people making those calls and keep it clear we represent District 70 as a whole. We will continue to answer calls and help people find information and help for ALL of the groups in District 70

**ALT-DCM** On Saturday September 16th I attended the Area 20 Fall Assembly. There are Conference Final Report Books here. Please bring one back for one for your group. The Area held elections that day and most of the committee chairs rotated out after serving a two-year term and took on new roles or chairs.
