Late Work Policy:

The expectation is that students are meeting learning objectives and deadlines by turning work in on time. However, we understand that life happens. Should a student need to turn in an assignment late, please email the teacher to let them know when the completed work has been submitted. The final deadline for late assignments will be the last day of the unit of study. Late work turned in by the last day of the unit is eligible for full credit.

Class Notebooks:

Students are expected to keep a neat and organized notebook as a record of their learning. Specific requirements vary from subject to subject. Teachers will be checking and grading these regularly.

Tardy Policy:

Tardiness will not be tolerated. Students need to come to class prepared i.e. pencil/pen, notebook, textbook, Chromebook, and planner. If students are not in their seats when the bell rings, they will receive a tardy for the class period. Excessive tardiness may result in an invitation to the lunchtime Homework Club.

Cheating/Plagiarism:

Cheating, which includes plagiarism and the use of AI without specific teacher permission, will not be tolerated and will result in an automatic "0" for that assignment, a Behavior Incident Report, and parent communication

Bathroom Breaks:

Bathroom visits need to be taken care of during the passing period between classes. In case of emergency, students will be allowed to use the restroom but must obtain a teacher signature in their planner and sign

out/in on the Bathroom Sheet at the front of the room. Students will not be allowed to leave the room, with the exception of an emergency, for the first and last ten minutes of class.

Food and Drinks:

You may have a water bottle. No other food or drinks will be allowed. **Gum is not allowed**. Nuts are not allowed in any classroom.

Electronics and Fidgets:

Students will be expected to bring their <u>fully charged Chromebook</u> in its case to class daily. Electronic devices other than school-issued Chromebooks will not be allowed in class. Teachers will inform students when it is appropriate to be using their Chromebooks in class. Distracting fidgets of any kind are not appropriate in the classroom.

Chromebooks:

You must come each day with a <u>fully charged Chromebook</u> in its case. Because we utilize technology so much in class, you must do this so that you can fully participate. If you do not, you are still expected to complete the work, but it becomes that much more difficult. It is less work to charge your Chromebook than it is to try to navigate your day without it. Multiple infractions (a forgotten Chromebook or a not fully charged Chromebook) will result in consequences such as additional paper practice, an invitation to lunchtime Homework Club, or the requirement that you leave your Chromebook in Mrs. Salgado's office each night to charge.

Movie Release:

My student is permitted to watch G and PG-rated videos provided by their teachers, including movies and documentaries located in the Flagstaff Academy library. All films and videos will directly relate to the classroom curriculum and content.
