

INSTRUCTIONS FOR YURT YASMIN

Thank you for booking Yurt Yasmin. The address of the property is Holycombe, Whichford, Shipston on Stour, Warks CV36 5PH. Please note that we do not allow children under the age of 12 and we do not allow dogs.

DIRECTIONS: Are on the website www.holycombe.com under "How to find us". You can arrive any time after 3pm and you need to leave by 11am on the day of departure to enable us to clean. When you arrive there are 2 entrances, one, at the bottom of the dip in the road, with a wooden sign that says 'Holycombe' and the other, at the top of hill going South, that says 'Cotswolds Camping at Holycombe'. Come in the entrance that says "Cotswolds Camping at Holycombe". You will see a stone circle to your right as you enter. Follow the obvious pathway past the stones and cross into the next field. Once you are across into the next field you turn left and drive past the bell tent and park the other side of that. There, to your right if you are looking back towards the entrance, you will see Yurt Yasmin. There is no official reception, and there may not be anyone to greet you when you arrive (we used to do signing in the camp kitchen but currently doing contactless check in).

THE KEY:

The key will be in the door.

YURT FURNISHINGS. It has a wood burning stove, wooden floor, a kelim rug, a double bed and sofa.

Decorated with beautiful Indian hangings and cushions, there are also electric lights and plug, a table, and candle lantern. We provide fresh bedding but please bring your own towels. There is a sink, electric kettle, 2 ring hob and toaster in the yurt. The bathroom for the Yurt is opposite Yasmin. There is a table and chairs along with a fire pit outside the Yurt. If you wish to cook on the firepit you will need to bring your own bbq grill and tools. We have limited supply on site.

FIRE WOOD. If you have not pre-ordered wood then you can buy it for £6 a bag, and it is stored as you cross the water on the left. Please make payment into the honesty box in the camping kitchen or go to cotswoldscamping.com/shop

CAMPING FACILITIES. . Yasmin has a fridge in the room, but should you need a freezer there is a communal one outside the (closed) Cafe.

Can we remind you that we are a designated quiet campsite, and we have sensitive planning issues with neighbours. If any other camper is making a noise, please don't hesitate to call us or better still remind them about the quiet nature of our site!
