# #TrustTeens Campaign, May 27 - May 31, 2024

# Why #TrustTeens?

We call for policies and practices that **#TrustTeens** with their bodies and respect their bodily autonomy. We see an alarming increase in threats to adolescents' bodily autonomy, including denying teens comprehensive sex education, barriers to confidential contraceptive services, and heightened restrictions on abortion access for minors. Restrictions on abortion access, like recent <u>abortion trafficking</u> laws, are specifically targeting teens and their ability to exercise reproductive autonomy.

Decades of research have demonstrated that teens are capable of making their own decisions about their bodies. Narratives that young people are immature and incapable of making responsible decisions fuel restrictive policies and stand in opposition to the human rights that young people deserve.

The goal of **#TrustTeens** is to flip this narrative and share many perspectives on why we as a nation should trust teens with their bodies and how this should influence policies and clinical practice. **We want to call in advocates working with and for teens to join us and tell the world why they should <b>#TrustTeens**.

### How to Use the Toolkit

There are a few ways that you can participate in the #TrustTeens social media campaign:

- 1. **Share a tweet** telling the world why you #TrustTeens and encourage others to join the movement. Create your own message or borrow one from our <u>Tweet Bank</u>.
- 2. **Post to Instagram** (or any other social media) with one of our <u>digital graphics</u>. Graphics include caption ideas that you can copy or use for inspiration.
- Create and share a video about why you #TrustTeens and why others should too!

# Statistics/Information to Uplift

With Roe v. Wade overturned, 54% of US adolescents live in states that are hostile to abortion access. That's nearly 8 million adolescents who have lost bodily autonomy, reproductive freedom, and control of their futures. #AbortionIsHealthcare #TrustTeens (Youth Reproductive Equity Key Messages)

Teens under 20 make up 12% of individuals who have abortions nationally; minors under 18 account for about 4% of all abortions in the U.S. This means at least 50,000 adolescents need abortion care each year in the United States. #TrustTeens (<u>Jerman et al., 2016</u>)

Too many teens get too little sex education. In 2015-19, only about 50% of adolescents reported that they received sex ed that meets the minimum standard articulated in Healthy People 2030. Comprehensive sex education is essential for adolescent reproductive autonomy. #TrustTeens (Lindberg & Kantor, 2021)

In addition to the 12 states where abortion is banned entirely, only 13 states allow minors access to abortion without parental consent or notification. We must #TrustTeens to make decisions about their own bodies by advocating for state policies that support bodily autonomy. (Guttmacher, 2023)

Access to confidential contraception is crucial for adolescent reproductive autonomy, but only 23 states and the District of Columbia explicitly allow all minors to consent to contraceptive services. #TrustTeens (Guttmacher, 2023)

Teens' birth control access is under threat. A recent court decision in Texas means Title X Family Planning programs are no longer required to provide confidential care for minors,

removing an important safety net for access to care. #TrustTeens (<u>Johnson and Lindberg</u>, 2023).

Depictions of the teen "abortion road trip" in the media pale in comparison to the harsh reality post-Dobbs. Legal barriers like parental involvement laws force teens to travel farther to access abortion. It's time to #TrustTeens and remove unnecessary obstacles to healthcare.




# **Instagram Stories**

Confidential care is essential for adolescent reproductive autonomy. Therefore, we must #TrustTeens to make decisions about their own bodies.







### How to Record a Trust Teens Video

Step 1: Introduce yourself and your relationship to adolescent health or reproductive justice
→ "Hi, my name is \_\_\_\_\_\_. I work with teens in [x capacity]."
→ "Hi, I am \_\_\_\_\_, I am \_\_\_\_\_ years old from \_\_\_\_\_.

**Step 2:** Share why you trust teens, why others should trust teens, or a personal experience related to adolescent reproductive health.

- → "I trust teens because..."
- → "I'm fired up about #TrustTeens because..."
- → "I've had the personal experience of \_\_\_\_. We need to trust teens because..."
- → I think teens should be able to make decisions about their bodies because..."
- → I think adults should trust teens to make decisions because...."
- → As a young person, I think teens need ...."

# Content Guidelines/Suggestions

Goal	Do	Don't
Use inclusive, gender-neutral language	"Abortion is a human right	"Abortion is a woman's choice"
	"We support a pregnant teen in however they choose to manage their pregnancy"	"We support a pregnant girl in however she chooses to manage her pregnancy"
	Reproductive health/equity	Women's health
Sexual and Reproductive Health focus (rather than political or abortion-only)	Focus on policy	Focus on the party/affiliations putting forth the policy
	"Opponents of abortion" and "opponents of contraceptive access"	Republicans, GOP, conservatives, etc.
	"Advocates for" or "supporters of abortion access"	Democrats, DNC, liberals, etc.
	"Anti-abortion"	"Pro-life"
Adolescent centered	Uplift youth voices	Sensationalize youth trauma (e.g. Ohio 10-year old rape victim)
Reproductive justice	Center access	Center choice
	Focus on SRH comprehensively	Focus on abortion only
	Center the most marginalized	Ignore intersecting identities and those who face the most oppression
