

Happy Snowy Day to all of you!

The performance is a week away! Kids, parents, and staff are working on their parts to support this community effort! Indeed our theme this year is "Community in Winter." It really takes a village to put on a show, and your kids are the stars! In order to help them shine here are a few details to keep in mind...

Please....

- ❄️ Arrive with your child at the Camp Sherman Community Hall at 5:30PM; show begins at 6:00PM.
- ❄️ Make sure that they have eaten a nutritious dinner before and are hydrated.
- ❄️ Have their hair/make up (optional!) finished before arriving, with only finishing touches to complete at the Hall.
- ❄️ Consider bringing a potluck dessert item to share with the community following the performance.
- ❄️ Once they arrive, encourage your kiddo(s) to first go to the bathroom, then they will get into costume. There is a changing room upstairs, and bathrooms downstairs for changing. It is helpful for the kids who will change into costumes to have on neutral colored, tight-fitting clothing that they can wear under their costume, so they do not need to fully undress to get into their costume. Once they arrive you and/or teachers will help your child get into their costume, if needed. After costumes are on, kids will gather upstairs to warm up.
- ❄️ During the performance, your kiddo(s) will be sitting with you for a portion of the show. When you arrive, Mr. Sharp and/or Ms. Molly will give you a sticky note to reserve your child's chair. The first rows will be reserved for families.
- ❄️ Keep your phones away during the performance. We are fortunate to have Kelly Carter with [Rise Graphic Design](#), photographing the show. Molly Schultz will be taking video. The video will be provided to you at no charge. Kelly has offered \$5 downloads for any photographs she provides. (You can find past show videos at: <https://vimeo.com/blackbutteschool>.)
- ❄️ After the show, we are trying something new! This year we would like students to be a part of the striking of the show after the dessert potluck and celebration.
