Parent Tips: Transitioning Back to School

Help yourself and help your student! The list below are great tips to keep in mind when returning to school and setting up routines!

- **Set Up a Launch Pad** Create a designated spot at home for backpacks, lunchboxes, and school materials to make mornings easier.
- Talk About the Excitement Share positive conversations about what's ahead—new teachers, friends, and fun learning opportunities.
- Create a Calm Morning Plan Prep lunches, snacks, and outfits the night before to keep mornings less stressful.
- Fuel Up Make sure kids have a healthy breakfast to start the day focused and ready to learn
- Practice Independence Encourage children to pack their own bag, tie their shoes, or double-check their homework to build confidence.
- **Review Safety & Routines** Walk or drive the route to school, review bus stops, and talk about dismissal procedures together.
- **Stay Connected** Check teacher newsletters, school emails, and the website so your family is in the loop.
- Create After-School Space Set aside time to talk about the day—what went well, what was tricky, and what they're excited about tomorrow.
- Celebrate the Little Wins Whether it's surviving the first morning drop-off or finishing a first homework assignment, celebrate progress!
