PELS Board Relicensure for Tier 3 & 4 Teaching and **Administrative Licenses**

The Relicensure Committee meets several times throughout the school year (see dates below). The Committee reviews documentation submitted by Teachers and Administrators needing to renew their Tier 3 or 4 administrative and teaching licenses. Tier 3 & 4 teaching re-licensure requirements are established by The Professional Educators License and Standards Board (PELSB) and applications are approved or denied by the committee. Administrative re-licensure requirements are established by the Minnesota Board of School Administrators and Standards Board and applications are approved or denied by the committee.

PowerSchool transcript and if necessary, any additional clock hours certificate and transcripts must be submitted to the Relicensure Committee.

Note: Committee meetings are closed to the public except for the Open House. The committee does not meet or review renewal materials from June thru November but will, if needed, in certain circumstances. Check SPPS Relicensure Web Page for updated dates of when the Relicensure Committee convenes in December. You are required to be licensed by the first day you work.

Important Renewal Information:

- Submit clock hours to the committee by May 28th, 2026
- Submit clock hours to the committee ONLY when you have met ALL requirements to renew
- A teacher requesting renewal of a Tier 4 license must earn 125 clock hours during each five-year licensure period from the date of renewal to June 30 of the year of expiration. Also, a teacher requesting renewal of a Tier 3 license must earn 75 clock hours during each 3-year licensure period from the date of renewal to June 30 of the year of expiration. Within the clock hours necessary to relicense, you will need to fulfill eight requirements listed under categories N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U
- Clock hours above and beyond required clock hours required for the licensure period **may not be banked** for future renewals.
- Once your materials have been **approved** by the committee you will receive **an email 7** business days after the committee meets detailing further instructions on final steps of how to pay for your license on the PELSB website.
