

CLIMATE CHANGE TALKING POINTS

- Climate change is one of the greatest environmental AND public health challenges we face. Source
- Trump wants to cut the EPA budget by 31% (<u>source</u>) it will be the lowest funding level in 40 years and cut NOAA by 20%, (<u>source</u>) eliminating many coastal grant programs and climate change monitoring.
- The head of the EPA, Scott Pruitt, is a climate change denier. He wants to roll back existing regulations and exit us from the Paris Agreement in order to support the coal & fossil fuel industry. Same is true for billionaire Wilbur Ross, Commerce Secretary (NOAA). Source
- Pruitt and Trump have halted regulation that limits dumping of toxic metals by power plants into waterways.
 Source We will have more cities like Flint, Michigan.
- Increased lead in water causes developmental delay in children and other significant health issues. Source
- Rolling back the Clean Power Plan will increase health care costs by contributing to smog and pollution. Source
- The Clean Power Plan was set to decrease carbon pollution 32% by 2030, saving ~\$14-34 billion in health benefits, and ~\$20 billion in climate benefits. <u>Source</u>
- The Dakota Access Pipeline (DAPL) poses a threat to the drinking water of nearby communities, especially the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe. Their reservation is immediately downstream of where the pipeline crosses the Missouri River. <u>Source</u>
