

Quantitative Analysis


Project Type

The most prevalent project type was "Personal Project", followed by "Commercial".



Likelihood to keep using

The likelihood to keep using the API is high. All the signals received are positive, and the biggest sentiment is "Extremely Likely".




API Shape feedback

The API users generally had no problem using the API. The two biggest buckets for difficulty were "Extremely Easy" and "Neither easy nor difficult".

It does indicate that the API shape is fairly well suited for the responders' use-cases.

Caveats

Survivorship Bias

The sample size was small. We've had feedback submissions from the Origin Trial renewal form, which introduces survivorship bias.

Sample Size

We've had 25 submissions for renewal, which is a low number for statistical significance.

Persistence of some sort for handles is the highest requested additional capability.

The next broad category is filepicker control improvements:

- choosing the default location for opening files
- Filtering file by mime-type or regular expression for opening files
- A default name or extension when saving files

Other requested features are: reducing the number of prompts, the file handle providing the path on disk or a virtual path, seeking/appending to files.

File Handling has its own upcoming Origin Trial. The spec work is done on github.

We will follow up with a second Origin Trial. The table above marks the features that we intend to test in a second Origin Trial.
