

# **Student Directions for Uploading Documents**

**Step 1:** Prepare one document prior to uploading – it must be in electronic form

- ~ English HL Essay (WA) – one document with all parts included (reflective statement and assignment)
- ~ EE – **one** document. RPPF is separate and uploaded by Mr. Liddle. Please know category or strand if applicable (Lang A/B and World Studies)
- ~ TOK Essay – one document and you must report the question # you addressed.

**Candidate names included in uploaded work:** Please do not include candidate name, session number or personal code on work uploaded unless otherwise specified/requested; in other words, no separate cover page is necessary; however, the EE does include a title page.

Documents saved in this format:

**Step 2:** Download your document and save as a pdf.

**Step 3:** Go to [candidates.ibo.org](https://candidates.ibo.org) and log in using your personal IB codes located in ManageBac.

**Step 4:** To continue, you must agree to the Terms and Conditions listed on the page.

**Step 5:** Your courses using the ecoursework system should be listed.

**Step 6:** Upload the WA, EE, and TOK essay. When each component is complete, the status will change to “Complete”

When uploading TOK, you will need to include the **topic number** you addressed.  
EEs in English, Lang B and World Studies need the category or strand.

**Step 7:** The system will indicate that all files have been uploaded successfully and a “Submit” button will appear.

**Step 8:** Click on the checkbox to confirm that the work is your own and the final version, then hit “Submit for assessment”

- 1. In the production of knowledge, does it matter that observation is an essential but flawed tool? Discuss with reference to the natural sciences and one other area of knowledge.**
- 2. To what extent do you agree that doubt is central to the pursuit of knowledge? Answer with reference to two areas of knowledge.**
- 3. Is the power of knowledge determined by the way in which the knowledge is conveyed? Discuss with reference to mathematics and one other area of knowledge.**
- 4. In the acquisition of knowledge, can we only understand something to the extent that we understand its context? Discuss with reference to two areas of knowledge.**
- 5. To what extent do you agree with the claim that “all things are numbers” (Pythagoras)? Answer with reference to the arts and the human sciences.**
- 6. To what extent is interpretation a reliable tool in the production of knowledge? Answer with reference to history and one other area of knowledge.**
