

Admission

Admission is \$10 at the gate. They will accept cash or card. Children 6 or under get in for free.

Spectator Parking

Refer to the map for specifics. Spectator parking will begin in the parking lot between the performance field and the school, followed by our back teacher parking lot, followed by United Memorial Methodist Church, which is on the corner of the spectator entrance off of North Miles St. Any more parking that is needed will either occur in American Legion Park (this is right next to the school) or our grass practice field, as a last resort. If your parents have the ability to carpool, that would help alleviate some possible issues.

Equipment Parking

Refer to the map for specifics. Spots were determined by the number of vehicles listed on the KMEA sheets. The space of the actual trucks is probably tight for most in the front parking lot, but you can use the indicated spaces for equipment overflow and prop construction. Any school with a semi is either located in our softball complex parking lot (Central Hardin) or our elementary school, Panther Academy, on our campus (Taylor County, Adair County, Ohio County).

Bus Parking

Buses will enter through the Mulberry entrance (main entrance), drop off students at the loop, then will be parked off campus at T.K. Stone Middle school, which is about a half a mile from the school. If you are going to need access to the bus for the time between prelims and finals, please let me know and I can alert my parent volunteers for this.

Performance Field

The gate to enter the field is 14 feet wide. We are allowed to have smaller vehicles on the field for pulling equipment, as long as they are not bigger than a typical four-seater side-by-side. ATVs are fine as well. No trucks or anything of that nature. Please try to avoid making sharp turns on the field or the track to avoid any issues. The turf is brand new as of this summer so I would like to be able to host this event in the future!

Front ensembles will be able to prestage against the fence up until the 20 yard line (a la BOA). Everyone else will veer left and set up off the field until the previous band has exited. The goal line is the timeline. We will have someone there to help facilitate this.

The entrance is also the exit. No one should exit the side two gate. It is not as wide and the path is not as wide either. Once a band finishes, get water at the tent and then circle back around the back of the track. You are welcome to watch the band after you if you would like. The map should make this clear.
