Each floor of Urness Hall has a communal bathroom. All community members assigned to the floor share the showers, toilets, and sinks in each communal bathroom, which is regularly cleaned by University Facilities staff.

Provided Furniture

Furniture provided in each bedroom space for each community member is as follows:

- Twin extra-long bed frame and bed springs

Laundry detergent and stain removers

A microfridge (combined microwave and mini-fridge) is provided in each Urness bedroom for the roommates to share.
