



What to Bring Guide

Urness Hall

In Urness Hall, you will share a bedroom with one other person, your roommate (unless you are assigned to a single bedroom).

Each floor of Urness Hall has a communal bathroom. All community members assigned to the floor share the showers, toilets, and sinks in each communal bathroom, which is regularly cleaned by University Facilities staff.

Provided Furniture

Furniture provided in each bedroom space **for each community member** is as follows:

- Desk (built-in)
- Desk chair
- Dresser
- **Twin extra-long** mattress
- **Twin extra-long** bed frame and bed springs

A **microfridge** (combined microwave and mini-fridge) is provided in each Urness bedroom for the roommates to share.

All furniture in your space at your move-in must remain there. Residence Life does not provide furniture removal and storage services.

Non-University-issued refrigerators or freezers, non-University-issued mattresses, bed frames, and bed springs are prohibited in Residence Hall spaces. Please refer to the [Residence Life Handbook](#) for more information about prohibited items.

Recommended Items

SLEEP

- ☐ **Twin extra-long** sheet set
- ☐ **Twin extra-long** comforter and blankets
- ☐ **Twin extra-long** mattress pad
- ☐ Pillows and pillow cases

All beds in Urness Hall are **TWIN EXTRA-LONG**. Beds can be lofted by purchasing a loft kit through BedLoft.

WASH

- ☐ Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, etc.)
- ☐ Towels and washcloths
- ☐ Robe or towel wrap (for walking from your room to the communal bathroom)
- ☐ Shower caddy
- ☐ Shower shoes

LAUNDRY

- ☐ Laundry basket
- ☐ Laundry detergent and stain removers
- ☐ Dryer sheets

- ☐ Clothes hangers
- ☐ Clothes steamer with an automatic shut-off feature

A shared laundry room is located in the basement of Urness Hall. Use of the washers and dryers is free for all Urness community members.

CLEAN

- ☐ Wastebasket
- ☐ Garbage bags
- ☐ Cleaning sprays, towels, or cleaning wipes
- ☐ Dish soap
- ☐ Sponges or dish scrubbers
- ☐ Dish towels or paper towels
- ☐ Personal vacuum
- ☐ Bins, storage totes, and organizers

University Facilities staff clean all common areas of Urness Hall (lounges, hallways, bathrooms, etc.), but community members are responsible for cleaning their assigned rooms. Please refer to the [Residence Life Handbook](#) for more information about cleaning expectations.

EAT

- ☐ Favorite snacks and drinks
- ☐ Reusable bowl, plate, cup/mug, and utensils
- ☐ Reusable food-storage containers
- ☐ Reusable water bottle and travel mug
- ☐ Can opener
- ☐ Personal appliances with an automatic shut-off feature, like a coffee maker, electric kettle, or personal blender

All Urness rooms have a MicroFridge that all roommates share. There is no common kitchen in Urness Hall.

Open coil and open heating element cooking appliances are prohibited in Residence Life spaces, including but not limited to: toasters, electric grills, hot plates, and pressure cookers. Cooking appliances that use heat must have an automatic shut-off feature to be used within Residence Life Spaces. Please refer to the [Residence Life Handbook](#) for more information about prohibited items.

STUDY

- ☐ Notebooks, folders, binders, sticky notes, index cards
- ☐ Pens, pencils, highlighters
- ☐ Stapler, staples, scissors, calculator
- ☐ Backpack
- ☐ Calendar or planner

DECORATE

- ☐ Desk lamp
- ☐ Potted plants
- ☐ Pictures and posters
- ☐ Removable mounting products (such as CommandStrips), poster putty, or painters' tape
- ☐ Area rugs
- ☐ Indoor use power strips with surge protection

Some decorative items, like adhesive LED light strips and television wall mounts, are prohibited in Residence Hall spaces. Please refer to the [Residence Life Handbook](#) for more information about prohibited items.

GOOD TO HAVE

- ☐ Fan for air circulation
 - *Urness Hall is not air-conditioned; personal air conditioner units are prohibited in Residence Hall spaces.*
- ☐ Headphones
- ☐ Batteries
- ☐ Extra charging cords (we recommend long ones!) and bases
- ☐ Wellness supplies (pain relievers, cold medicine, cough drops, etc.)
- ☐ Personal first aid kit
- ☐ Personal tool set
- ☐ Flashlight
- ☐ Lanyard or key chain for room keys
