

CIS Field Day Schedule for Spring 2026

- Three days of Field Days encompassing multiple sessions.
- 3 minute class presentation on any topic.
- Estimated class size and number of sections is given for each school.
- The small group topic is currently planned to be: Climate Change in Minnesota
- **Optional but not necessary: reserve one day in class to practice the Field Day model and ask students to bring notes to Field Day.**
