Hi there, and welcome to my FTH fan crafts stall! I crochet amigurumi, and I'm offering a few critters to hopefully brighten up someone's day.

I have a few critters that are ready to ship, and I am also offering 2 custom slots for either a wee critter or a regular sized one. More details are below.

~~1. Wee Pastel Triceratops- \$25 CLAIMED!~~

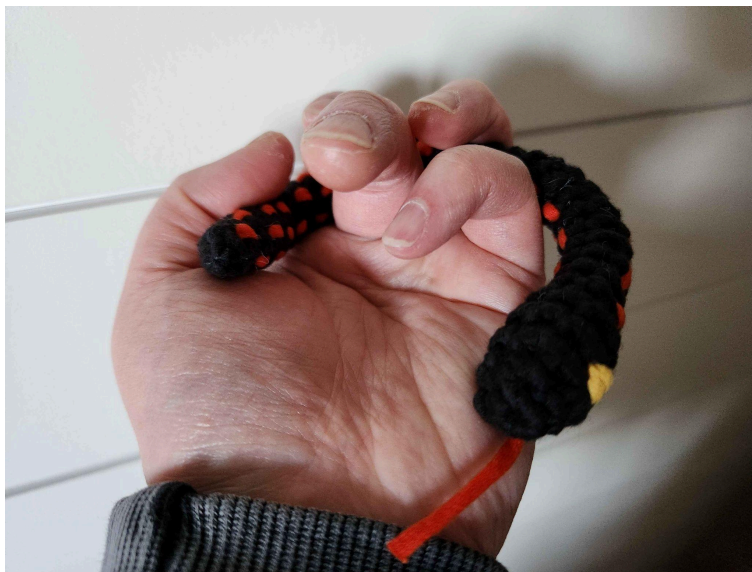
(2.5" or 6.35cm tall and 1.5" or 3.84cm wide)





2. ~~Smol-Snek~~ (aka demonic danger noodle)- \$25 **CLAIMED!**
(7" or 17.78cm long and 0.5" or 1.27cm wide; this little guy is also bendable!)





3. ~~Wee Dark Green Nessie~~ — \$20 **CLAIMED!**

(3" or 7.6 cm tall and 1" or 2.54cm wide, excluding tail)



~~4. Wee Pastel Brontosaurus \$25~~ CLAIMED!

(a little smaller than 3" or 7.6 cm tall and 1" or 2.54cm wide, excluding tail)

From there, we can discuss further details regarding donation proof and shipping.

I am based in the U.S., and will cover domestic shipping costs. If you are outside of the U.S., I will ask to split shipping costs.

Ready to ship critters are first come, first serve. I will update this document accordingly once a critter has been claimed.

Thanks so much for your support! I will be reaching out to the winning bidders about next steps regarding donations (due on March 12th), critter and/or yarn choices and other logistics.

The options below are what are available for custom critters:

A. ONE Custom Crocheted Wee Sized Critter (3" or 7.62cm tall)- choose between a small Brontosaurus OR a Nessie.

Winning bidder will get to choose from a selection of yarn body colors and eye colors used for embroidery, as well as yarn type. I typically use t-shirt yarn, but I also have a few other kinds as well.

B. ONE Custom Crocheted Regular Sized Jellyfish (3.5" or 8.9cm long and 2.5" or 6.35cm wide, or slightly bigger).

Winning bidder will get to choose from a selection of yarn body colors and eye colors used for embroidery, as well as yarn type. I typically use t-shirt yarn, but I also have a few other kinds as well. There is also an option to include ties or no ties (in case you wanted to hang your jellyfish somewhere!).

ADDITIONAL CUSTOM CROCHET SLOT INFO

Custom wee critters as well as jellyfish are all made-to-order. I will do what I can to get each piece created and shipped as soon as I can, but please note it may take up to 1-2 months from creation and shipping to postal delivery.

Bidding is open from now until Monday, March 10th, 6pm EST.

Once bidding ends, I will reach out to each winner of each for proof of donation to an approved non-profit. **Proof of donation is due by Wednesday, March 12.** I will reply to confirm once received. From there, we can coordinate on color choices and whatever else you'd like for your

custom crochet buddy. :D

I am based in the U.S., and will cover domestic shipping costs. If you are outside of the U.S., I will ask to split shipping costs 50/50. Please look up how much the cost is for shipping a standard 1-3 oz parcel ahead of time before you place a bid.
