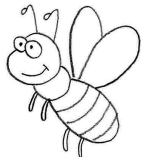

Allergic Reaction to Bee Stings



Dear Parent/Guardian,

Reactions to a bee sting may vary with each person. The majority of people stung by a bee will get a reaction consisting of redness, itching, swelling, burning pain and warmth over the area of the sting, which may last a few hours. However, a more severe reaction may result from multiple stings, or to persons having an allergy to bee stings. An allergic reaction can be severe and even fatal. You have indicated that your child has a bee sting allergy. I am trying to update your child's health records.
