The results of these assessments help guide our faculty in setting goals for Arapahoe's academic school improvement and professional development each year. They are also helpful in identifying appropriate academic interventions for individual students. Results from the SAT taken as juniors can be used for college and scholarship applications in the senior year. Many colleges and universities will take the best scores on the SAT, so the State SAT results can help individuals identify areas where they can better prepare through additional coursework to try to improve their scores. **We encourage and expect our Warriors to do their very best on these important exams**. As parents, you can help by ensuring students get plenty of rest, eat well, and attend school each day throughout the important testing period.

Another exciting opportunity for our Warriors that typically brings happiness each spring is the opportunity to visit or host many of our **friends from the Wind River Indian Reservation in Riverton**, **Wyoming**. Representatives from the Arapaho and other tribes come to sing, dance, and speak in many of our classes to teach us about their culture and traditions; or we travel to their home, visit their schools, and meet many of their faculty, staff, and students. We look forward to the day we are able to continue these traditions that renew and foster this very unique relationship with the people for whom our school was named.



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Important Attendance Reminders

Please read the following instructions/guidelines for student/parent attendance-taking and absence excusal during our Hybrid schedule.

Important Need to Know Attendance Reminders:

- 1. Students are responsible for recording their attendance in Infinite Campus on every remote learning day.
- 2. Teachers will take attendance for in-person classes ONLY.
- 3. Attendance forms should be submitted ONLY due to illness, Positive Covid-19 Test or EXPOSURE to COVID-19.
- 4. If there is a mistake on an attendance record for remote/virtual days, parents or guardians may call the attendance line and leave a message. If you believe your student was marked absent in error for an in person class please have the student stop by the attendance office for a change slip.
- 5. The attendance window for each day will be open from 8:00 am through 4:00 pm. Students must take their own attendance during that time or they will be marked "Unexcused Absent."

<u>Student:</u> Recording Attendance on Remote/Virtual Days:

- 1. Student logs into the Infinite Campus Student Portal: <u>https://littletonco.infinitecampus.org/campus/portal/students/littleton.jsp</u>
- 2. The students' class schedule will be on the right hand side.
- 3. Click on each class individually.
- 4. Click on the blue YES I'M HERE button.
- 5. For more detailed explanations and screenshots, <u>click here</u>.

Parent: Recording an Absence on In-Person & Virtual Days:

- 1. Call the Arapahoe attendance line (303-347-6030) to leave a clear and concise message to excuse an absence. You may call this line 24/7.
- 2. Follow the attendance line instructions by listening to the pre-recorded voicemail.
- 3. Parents/Guardians are the only members of the family who may excuse an absence. Per AHS Policy, absences may only be excused within 24 hours after the absence. Please call as soon as you are aware that he/she will be absent from school.
- 4. Leave your message with the following information:
 - Student's full name, please spell out the last name.
 - Date(s) of absence(s).
 - Specific reason for absence ("personal" is not specific enough per LPS/AHS policy).

Passes: When a student needs to leave during a class period

- In order to leave during a class period for scheduled appointments, students must pick up a pass from the Attendance Office PRIOR to the class they will be leaving.
- Passes ARE NOT DELIVERED.
- Teachers do not allow students to leave class without a pass.
- A parent must leave a message on the attendance line as early as possible to arrange for the pass.
- Please have your student sign in at the Attendance Office upon returning from an appointment.
- A student does not need a pass if they are leaving school during a passing period or off period.

Delays and Closures

In case of an emergency or severe weather conditions, please check the LPS or AHS website for a prominent announcement in a **red or yellow banner** across the top of the page regarding changes in school schedules. If there is no red or yellow banner, all schools are on a *normal* schedule.

The district will send a communication to all LPS families when school schedule changes occur. Families are encouraged to keep their contact information and contact preferences in their Infinite Campus Parent Portal account updated. Most Denver news stations announce these changes as well.

We encourage all LPS and AHS families to set their message preferences to receive a text message when weather-related decisions are made:

- 1. Log in to your Infinite Campus Parent Portal
- 2. Click the profile icon
- 3. Click "Settings"
- 4. Click "Contact Preferences"
- 5. In rows Priority" and "Emergency" select "Text (SMS)"
- 6. Click "Save" at the bottom of the screen.

You can change this preference at any time. Standard text message (SMS) rates may apply.

Remember: weather-related decisions are made early in the morning and a text may be delivered to your phone before 5 a.m. Charges are dependent upon your service plan, which may include fees from your carrier to send and receive these text (SMS) messages.

For 2020–2021, weather delays and closures will be handled in the same way as in previous school years. A snow day will be a snow day for all learning models. Students and staff will not participate in remote learning.

Counseling and Mental Health Department News

Financial AID

Two specific financial aid sources are the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the CSS/Financial Aid Profile. All students applying for financial aid **MUST** complete the FAFSA. The <u>FAFSA forms</u> are **only** online. In addition, some colleges may also require the College Scholarship Service Profile or <u>CSS</u> <u>Profile</u>, which must be completed online, as well. Check with individual college financial aid offices to find out if the CSS Profile is required. Questions regarding FAFSA may be directed to their website, to 1-800-4FED AID(1-800-433-3243), or to individual colleges.

College Opportunity Fund

The <u>College Opportunity Fund (COF)</u>, created by the Colorado Legislature, provides a stipend to eligible undergraduate students. The stipend pays a portion of a student's total in-state tuition when they attend a Colorado public institution or a participating private institution.

Eligible undergraduate students must apply, be admitted, and enroll in a participating institution. Both new and continuing students are eligible for the stipend. Qualifying students may use the stipend for eligible undergraduate classes. The stipend is paid on a per-credit-hour basis to the institution at which the student is enrolled. The credit-hour amount will be set annually by the General Assembly.

Senior Information

College acceptances are **contingent** upon "successful completion" of both semesters of a student's senior year. If grades drop or if coursework quality declines, it is possible that an acceptance will be rescinded when the admission personnel at the college review the final transcript. Please encourage your students not to lose steam. Encourage them to keep their grades up and not miss class. Spend time with them during meal times and enjoy their company. They need you more than ever. Help them achieve this milestone with love and support.

College Board Testing

The **state-mandated SAT** will be administered at Arapahoe High School **to all juniors on Tuesday, April 13th**. In addition, the **PSAT9 and the PSAT10** will be administered on Wednesday, April 14th and Thursday, April 15th respectively to all freshmen and sophomores.

Concurrent Enrollment Classes

Students enrolled at Arapahoe High School have the opportunity to take Concurrent Enrollment classes during their time at Arapahoe High School through Arapahoe Community College. Please talk with your school counselor before signing up. To sign-up visit our <u>Concurrent Enrollment LPS website</u>.

Advanced Placement Information

Advanced Placement examinations will take place in May. An updated exam schedule was released on February 4th. Due to COVID protocols, logistics are being ironed out. There will be more specific communication to come. Please visit <u>AP Central</u> for dates and times.
