



Travel Teams

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What does my Travel Team registration cover?

A: Travel Team registration fees cover the following:

- the entry fees of the teams into their 2 tournaments plus the Babe Ruth League Pacific Northwest Regional Tournament (please see the 2025 Travel Team page on the website for information on tournaments for each team)
- the additional practices in Calgary and on the road with their travel team
- Travel Team coaches volunteer their time to coach the teams and travel, so coaches' transportation and accommodations are factored into the player registration fees
- insurance when practicing or playing as part of the travel teams
- Apparel: cage or batting jacket, warm up shirt, and hat (Travel Team jerseys are league-owned and are returned after the season)

Q: What about insurance?

A: The league provides basic insurance to the players when they are playing with the team at practices and tournaments. It is strongly recommended for families to have their own adequate travel insurance.

Q: Why are some of the Travel Team tournaments in the States?

A: Babe Ruth League, the organization we are chartered with, is based in the States, and is one of the only youth baseball leagues within a reasonable travel distance that have tournaments where 13u and 14u play on 60/90 diamonds (Baseball BC and Baseball Alberta play on 54/80 diamonds at those age categories). As part of BRL, we have entries into the Babe Ruth League Pacific Northwest Regional Tournaments for each travel team that we have. Some of these BRL tournaments are in the Pacific Northwest region in the United States, though we apply to host a Regional Tournament each year in Calgary. In 2023, we hosted the 18u BRL PNW Regional Tournament, and in 2024, we hosted the 14u Regionals. This year, in 2025 we are hosting the 14u PNW Regional Tournament in Calgary again.
