CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Palestinian Scholarship Initiative (PSI) invites eligible Palestinian students whose education has been disrupted by conflict to pursue an undergraduate or master's degree in Singapore. This community-driven initiative provides full-ride scholarships that cover tuition, accommodation, living expenses and other miscellaneous fees relating to the university study. The PSI aims to enable Palestinian students with a chance to pursue higher education that could unlock opportunities for them to build safe, meaningful lives and contribute to the global community.

The PSI aims to sponsor at least two Palestinian students for full-time study at Singapore's top universities starting in the **2025** academic year.

The scholarship will cover:

- Tuition Fees
- One (1) Round-trip International Travel in Economy
- Accommodation (on campus or otherwise)
- Living Expenses
- Public Transport Allowance
- Student Pass Application Fees
- Miscellaneous fees (including computer allowance)

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- Hold a Palestinian travel document or ID
- Meet the academic criteria for their intended course of study at one of the participating universities in Singapore, including English proficiency requirement
- Be between 18 to 35 years old
- Understands and values the cultural diversity of Singapore society and commits to upholding the country's values, policies and laws.

Applications for this scholarship open on **9th December 2024** and close on **30th March 2025**. Please apply for this scholarship after you have completed your university applications.

Before you apply, please note:

- Interested applicants should apply for this scholarship **after** completing the applications to their intended programmes of study in any of the participating universities.
- Application fees may be waived for certain universities if participants indicate that they intend to apply for the PSI scholarship in their university applications. Please refer to the instructions for each university in Annex 1.
- Eventually, applicants must be offered a place in a participating Singaporean university to be awarded the scholarship.

Important Guidelines and Considerations for the PSI Application Process

- The PSI is open to all Palestinians.
- The PSI values gender equality and encourages diverse applications.
- The PSI values applications who show a strong commitment to contributing to Palestinian society.
- PSI scholarship recipients must commit to the full duration of study on-campus in Singapore.
- The PSI programme has **no application fees**. Applicants should not be asked to pay for any services related to the application process. If you encounter such a request, or notice any irregularities, please report it to the PSI committee via email.
- Applicants must provide honest and consistent information throughout the application and interview process. The PSI has a zero-tolerance policy for falsifying documents or misrepresenting information. Any violations will result in permanent disqualification from the PSI.
- Incomplete applications will not be shortlisted. Please closely verify the eligibility requirements and the required documentation requested in the application form.
- The PSI committee is aware that applicants may face challenges related to missing documentation or limited access to technology. We are ready to assist applicants with any difficulties they may encounter during the application process. Please reach out to us via email if you need support.

Application Information Required:

- Personal information, including:
 - Current residential address
 - Marital status & number of dependants
- Singapore University Application details - List the universities & courses that you have applied for
- Personal Statement — The personal statement is your opportunity to introduce yourself to the scholarship committee. It should reflect who you are, your experiences, and your aspirations. The personal statement should be between **500 to 700 words**, and no longer than 800 words.

Here are some guiding questions to craft your personal statement:

- What are your long-term goals? What impact do you want to make, and how can your education support this?
- Discuss what you hope to gain from studying in Singapore and how this experience will contribute to your personal development and future contributions to society.
- Reflect on your personal strengths, such as your resilience, determination, adaptability, and commitment to your goals. You are encouraged to include examples of how you have demonstrated these qualities in any volunteer work, leadership roles, or community involvement.

Documents required in English:

1. Proof of your Palestinian Citizenship - Palestinian travel document or ID
2. Academic transcripts from your most recent education (A Levels, IB, SATs, GMAT, Bachelor's, etc.)
3. Proof of Proficiency in English for university study (IELTS, TOEFL, etc.)
 - a. If your education was completed in English and you are fluent in it, please indicate so.
4. Proof of **completed application** to participating universit(ies) in either
 - a. PDF of the email from the university that confirms the application process is completed
 - b. or a Screenshot of the confirmation page on the university application website with date and time shown

Optional documents:

5. Letter of recommendation (optional, maximum two)
6. Resume (including your leadership achievements, community involvement, awards and more)

*Please get an official translation of your documents if they are not in English.

Application results:

- Applicants can expect to receive their scholarship application results about one month after the closing date for applications.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who can apply?

- The PSI scholarship is open to all Palestinians who hold a Palestinian ID regardless of your current situation and location.

2. What if I don't have TOEFL or IELTS certificates? Can English proficiency requirements be waived?

- Scholars are expected to be proficient in English to ensure that they are able to keep up with the fast-paced and rigorous study environment in Singapore universities.
- If you have previously completed your education in English, the PSI Scholarship Administration Committee (SAC) can accept that as proof of English proficiency.
- For Singapore university applications, it is possible to use your previous education qualification conducted in English as proof of proficiency, subject to approval and consideration by each of the participating Singapore universities.
- Please refer to Annex 1 for the English proficiency requirements for each university.
- **Awarding of the PSI scholarship is contingent on the applicant receiving an offer from the participating university.** Hence, the PSI SAC will accept the same documents for English proficiency as the participating Singapore universities.
- **NEW! Sponsored TOEFL online tests:** For applicants with a high calibre of English and meet the university academic requirements, the PSI committee is offering financial assistance to take the TOEFL test. Please write an email with a description of your situation and qualifications to apply for financial aid to take the TOEFL test. Please note that financial assistance will be offered on a case by case basis.

3. What if I don't have the required documents?

- The participating Singapore universities require all applicants to submit the complete set of documents and information for admissions.
- The PSI Secretariat is currently reaching out to the Palestinian Ministry of Higher Education for advice on this matter.

4. Can someone apply to the Singapore universities on my behalf?

- No, students should apply to the Singapore universities on their own. Application guides for each university can be found online.

- Applicants are strongly advised not to pay anyone to do their applications on their behalf.
- Should you still require assistance, PSI Student Volunteers can provide *guidance* for university applications.

5. Can application fees / payment to Singapore universities be waived?

- Some participating universities have agreed to waive their application fees.
- Under the Scholarship section of the application form, please indicate that you are a Palestinian Scholarship Initiative scholarship applicant.
- If you do not see such an option and require assistance in paying for the application fees, financial assistance in paying for university application fees can be provided on a case by case basis. Please email us to apply.

6. Are PhD programmes covered under the PSI scholarship?

- PhD programmes are currently not eligible for the PSI scholarship.

7. I am mid-way through my studies in Gaza before my university was destroyed. Am I allowed to transfer to a Singapore university to continue my studies?

- We understand that this is the situation of many students in Gaza. However, we are currently not able to facilitate the transfer of students to

Singapore universities due to the different credit systems and curriculum structures.

- We recommend that students apply for the full degree programmes offered by the Singapore universities, and then appeal for credit exemptions once you have been admitted to the university. All credit transfer appeals are subject to the discretion of the universities.
